At Apple's annual shareholders meeting on January 24, 1994, an emotional Jobs introduced the Macintosh in a widely publicized address. *Andy Hertzfeld* described the scene as "poignant." While Jobs was a persuasive and charismatic leader for Apple, some of his employees felt that Jobs described him as an erratic and impulsive manager. An industry-wide sales slump towards the end of 1994 caused a deterioration in Jobs's working relationship with Sculley, as well as layoffs and disappointing sales performance. 
The iPhone (/ˈiːfəʊn/ eye-fone) is a line of Internet and multimedia-enabled smartphones marketed by Apple Inc. The first iPhone was unveiled by Steven Paul Jobs, then CEO of Apple, on January 9, 2007, and released on June 29, 2007. The 5th generation iPhone, the iPhone 4S, was announced on October 4, 2011, and released on October 14, 2011. The iPhone can function as a video camera (with recording) and as a standard feature with the iPhone 3GS was released), a camera phone, a portable media player, and an Internet client with email and Internet browsing capabilities, use text texts and receive visual voicemail, and has both Wi-Fi and 3G connectivity. The user interface is built around the device's multi-touch screen, including a virtual keyboard rather than a physical one. Third-party as well as Apple applications software is available from the App Store, which launched in mid-2008 and now has over 200,000 "apps" approved by Apple. These apps have diverse functions, including games, references, GPS navigation, social networking, security and advertising for television shows, films, and celebrities. There are five generations of iPhone models, each accompanied by one of the five major streams of iOS (formerly iPhone OS). The original iPhone was a GSM phone that established design precedents like screen size and button placement that have persisted through all models. The iPhone 3G added 3G cellular network capabilities and A-GPS location. The iPhone 3GS added a compass, faster processor, and higher resolution camera, including video recording at 480p. The iPhone 4 has a rear facing camera (720p video) and a front facing camera (at a lower resolution) for FaceTime (via calling and for use in other apps like Skype). The iPhone 4 featured higher-resolution 960x640 display; it was released on June 24, 2010. In the U.S., AT&T was the only authorized carrier until February 10, 2011, when a CDMA version of the iPhone 4 launched for Verizon. On October 4, 2011, Apple announced the iPhone 4S. The iPhone 4S added a higher resolution camera (8 megapixel) with 1080p video recording, face detection, and video stabilization, a faster, dual core processor, multi-structured wireless support (following a simple handset to operate on networks based on both GSM/UMTS and CDMA technologies), 640KHzSS support and a virtual language voice control system called Siri. It will be available in 16 GB and 32 GB, as well as a new 64 GB capacity. In the United States, it was announced that two new carriers, T-Mobile and Sprint, would begin carrying the iPhone 4 and iPhone 4S in October and November 2011, respectively.

iPod is a line of portable media players created and marketed by Apple Inc. The product lineup currently consists of the hard drive-based iPod Classic, the touchscreen iPod Touch, the compact iPod Nano, and the ultra-compact iPod Shuffle. iPod Classic models store music on an internal hard drive, while all other models use flash memory to enable their smaller size (the discontinued iPod Nano used a Microdrive miniature hard drive). As with many other digital music players, iPods can also serve as external hard storage devices. Storage capacity varies by model, ranging from 2 GB for the iPod Shuffle to 160 GB for the iPod Classic. The iPod line was announced by Apple on October 23, 2001, and released on November 10, 2001. All of the models have been redesigned multiple times since their introduction. The most recent iPod redesigns were introduced on September 1, 2010. Apple's iTunes software can be used to transfer music to the devices from computers using various versions of Apple Macintosh and Microsoft Windows operating systems. The same software also can be used to use iTunes on select computers cannot use iTunes, several other music alternatives are available for the iPod, iTunes and its alternatives may also transfer photos, videos, games, contact information, e-mail settings. With headphones, and software in iPod models supporting these features. Discontinued models of the line include the iPod Mini and the iPod Photo, the former being replaced by the iPod Nano, and the latter incorporated into the main iPod line (now the iPod Classic). In iOS versions prior to iOS 5, the iTunes branding is also used for the media player applications included with the iPhone and iPod; the iPhone version is essentially a combination of the Music and Videos apps in the iPod Touch. As of iOS 5, separate apps named "Music" and "Videos" are to be standardized across all iOS-powered products. While the iPhone and iPod have essentially the same media player capabilities as the iPod line, they are generally treated as separate products. In the last few years, iPhone and iPod sales have exceeded those of the iPod.

Jobs and Steve Wozniak met in 1971, when their mutual friend, Neil Tennant, introduced 21-year-old Wozniak to 19-year-old Jobs. In 1976, Wozniak invented the Apple I computer. Jobs, Wozniak, and Ronald Wayne founded Apple Computer in the garage of Jobs's parents in order to sell it.[24] They recruited marketing manager and engineer Mike Markkula in 1977. Apple recruited Mike Markkula from National Semiconductor to serve as CEO for what turned out to be the most successful career. In 1983, Jobs hired John Sculley away from Pepsi-Cola to serve as Apple's CEO.





iPad

The iPad (/ˈiːpæd/ eye-pad) is a line of tablet computers designed, developed and marketed by Apple Inc., primarily as a platform for audio-visual media including books, periodicals, movies, music, games, and web content. The iPad was introduced on January 27, 2010 by Apple's then-CEO Steve Jobs. Its size and weight fall between those of contemporary smartphones and laptop computers. The iPad runs the same operating system as the iPod Touch and iPhone—and can run its own applications as well as iPhone applications. Without modification, the iPad will only run programs approved by Apple and distributed via the Apple App Store (with the exception of a programs that run inside the iPad's web browser). Like iPhone and iPod Touch, the iPad is controlled by a multi-touch display—a departure from most previous tablet computers, which used a pressure-triggered stylus—as well as a virtual onscreen keyboard in lieu of a physical keyboard. The iPad uses a Wi-Fi connection to access local area networks and the Internet. Some models also have a 3G wireless network interface which can connect to WSPA or EV-DO data networks and on to the Internet. Since the release of iOS 5, the device does not need to be managed and opened by iTunes running on a personal computer via USB cable. Apple released the first iPad in April 2010, and sold 3 million of the devices in 80 days. During 2010, Apple sold 14.8 million iPads worldwide, representing 75 percent of tablet PC sales at the end of 2010. By the release of the iPad 2 in March 2011, more than 15 million iPads had been sold—selling more than all other tablet PCs combined since the iPad's release. In 2011, it is expected to take 83 percent of the tablet computing market share in the United States.

Influenced by such acts as David Bowie, Michael Jackson, Madonna and Queen, Lady Gaga is well recognized for her flamboyant, diverse and outrageous contributions to the music industry through fashion, performance and music videos. She has sold estimated 25 million albums and 64 million single worldwide, making her one of the best-selling music artists of all time. This is the most talented gladiator representative U.S. Olympic team boxing junior middleweight champion (up to 71 kg). Roy Jones - his name is the dream of any amateur boxer - a gold medal Olympic Games. The name with which he beat his older and hardened boxing fights opponents suggest that the advent of professional boxing with Roy gets a new, previously unknown quality, which for many years to establish itself as the defining, but only just a prediction soon came true, after all, a brilliant gold medal Roy never met. By decision of the judges, which was recognized as the worst in the history of the Olympic Games, the South Korean opponent Roy Park Ji-Han received the "gold", among 6-0. It was a surprise for both present at the fight fans for his father's Roy Jones Jr., and for himself a style champion. In connection with the scandal Touched International Olympic Committee (IOC) is an attempt to rectify the situation, handed the award to Roy Val Barker, which is awarded only to the best boxers, though it certainly could not have been replaced by Olympic gold medal. Curtis James Jackson III (born July 8, 1973), better known by his stage name **50 Cent**, is an American rapper, entrepreneur, investor, record producer, and actor. He rose to fame with the release of his album *Get Rich or Die Tryin'* (2005) and *The Massacre* (2005). His album *Get Rich or Die Tryin'* has been certified six times platinum by the RIAA.

Born in South Jamaica, Queens, Jackson began drug dealing at the age of twelve during the 1980s crack epidemic. After leaving drug dealing to pursue a rap career, he was shot at and struck by nine bullets during an incident in 2000. After releasing his album *Guess Who's Back?* in 2002, Jackson was discovered by rapper Eminem and signed to Interscope Records. With the help of Eminem and Dr. Dre, who produced his first major commercial successes, Jackson became one of the world's highest selling rappers. In 2003, he founded the record label G-Unit Records, which signed several successful rappers such as Young Buck, Lloyd Banks, and Tony Yayo.

Jackson has engaged in feuds with other rappers including Ja Rule, Nas, Fat Joe, Jay-Z, Jadakiss, Cam'ron, Puff Daddy, Rick Ross, and former G-Unit members The Game and Young Buck. He has also pursued an acting career, appearing in the semi-autobiographical film *Get Rich or Die Tryin'* in 2005, the Iraq War film *Habeo in the Blood* in 2006, and *Righteous Kill* in 2008. 50 Cent was ranked as the sixth best artist of the 2000s by *Billboard* magazine. The magazine also ranked him as the fourth top male artist and as the third top rapper behind Eminem and Nas. *Billboard* magazine also ranked him as the sixth best and most successful Hot 100 Artist of the 2000s and as the number one rap artist of the 2000s. *Billboard* ranked his album *Get Rich or Die Tryin'* as the seventh best album of the 2000s and his album *The Massacre* as the 27th best album of the 2000s. As of September 2011, 50 Cent is working on his yet-to-be-titled fifth studio album, which is set to be released in December 2011.

Early life

Curtis Jackson III grew up in the **South Jamaica** neighborhood of Queens, in New York City. He grew up without a father and was raised by his mother, Sabrina, who gave birth to him at the age of fifteen. Sabrina, a cocaine dealer, raised Jackson until the age of twelve, when she was killed in 1986. Twenty-seven at the time, she became unconscious after someone (stuffed her drink). She was then left for dead after the gas in her apartment was turned on and the windows shut closed. After her death, Jackson moved into his grandparents' house with his eight aunts and uncles.

Jackson began boxing around the age of eleven. At fourteen, a neighbor opened a boxing gym for local kids. In the mid 1980s, he competed in the Junior Olympics an amateur boxer. At the age of twelve, Jackson began dealing (selling) when his grandparents thought he was at after-school programs. He also took guns and drug money to school. In the tenth grade, he was caught by metal detectors at Andrew Jackson High School.

Following time spent in a **correctional boot camp**, Jackson adopted the nickname "50 Cent" as a metaphor for "change". The name was derived from **Kevin Martin**, a 1980s Brooklyn rapper known as "50 Cent".

Music career

1996–2000: Early career

Jackson started rapping in a friend's basement where he used turntables to record over instruments. In 1996, a friend introduced him to **Jam Master Jay** of **Run-DMC** who was organizing his label **Jam Master Jay Records**. Jay taught him how to count bars, write choruses, structure songs, and how to make a record. Jackson's first official appearance was on a song titled "Read" with the group **Onyx** on their 1998 album *Shut 'Em Down*. He credited **Jam Master Jay** as an influence who helped him improve his ability to write hooks. Jay produced Jackson's first album; however, it was never released. In 1999, after leaving **Jam Master Jay**, the platinum-selling producer Trackmasterstock notice of Jackson and signed him to **Columbia Records**. They sent him to a studio in **Upland, New York** where he produced thirty-six songs in two weeks. Eighteen were included on his unofficially released album, *Power of the Dollar* in 2000. He also started the now-defunct **Hollow Point Entertainment** with former G-Unit affiliate **Berg 'Em Street**.

In an interview with the British entertainment website **ContactMusic**, 50 Cent announced that he was working on a tenth album named *Black Magic*. 50 Cent said he was inspired by the European nightclubs. "First they played hip-hop which suddenly changed to uptempo songs, known as Eurodance". He went on *The Invasion Tour* in the summer of 2010, in support of *Before I Self Destruct* album, and the then shelved *Black Magic* album. He "recorded 20 songs to a whole different album concept" before he put those to the side and did something different.

50 Cent revealed that he wanted his new album to have the same "aggression" as his debut record, *Get Rich or Die Tryin'*. He later tweeted that the album was "90 percent done", and stated that fans can expect the album in the summer of 2011, however, the album has been delayed to 2012 at the earliest, due to tensions and disagreements at Interscope Records. Later 50 Cent said that he will release his album in November of 2011 and it has also been confirmed that "Black Magic" will not be the album's title. 50 Cent has already confirmed that Eminem will appear on the album, but he also confirmed that he has been working with new producers such as **Boi-1da** and **Alex da Kid**. **Cambai**, who produced **Lloyd Banks'** "Start 2 Fly", also confirmed that he had produced a song for the upcoming album.

Di Wase Kid confirmed in an interview that 50 Cent was filming a new movie with **Robert DeNiro** in **New Orleans**.

50 Cent released the first song from his fifth studio album, titled "Outlaw", to the internet on June 16, 2011. The single was produced by **Cambai**. It was released to iTunes on July 19, 2011, although 50 Cent confirmed through his Twitter account that the song was not the album's first single. 50 Cent is set to release a book titled *Playground*. Unlike his previous literary efforts — which focus on his life story and the rules of power — his time he's aiming at a teen audience with a semi-autobiographical novel about bullying. According to a statement from the book's publisher, the first-person novel is slated for release in January 2012 and will tell the story of a 13-year-old schoolyard bully "who finds redemption as he faces what he's done."

50 Cent has promised to deliver his fifth studio album over the past few years, but the LP may be delayed until 2012. In a series of tweets, 50 Cent explained that him and his label Interscope Records aren't on the same page on how to roll out the album and that he's delaying its release until they see eye to eye.

50 Cent later suggested that his album will be releasing in November 2011, along with his headphones the **DMS 30**. 50 Cent spoke to MTV in relation to the possibility of leaving **Interscope Records**. "I don't know," 50 said to MTV News when

Wealth

Richard Branson

Richard Charles Nicholas Branson (born 18 July 1950) is an English business magnate, best known for his Virgin Group of more than 400 companies.

His first successful business venture was a magazine called Student at age 18. In 1970, he set up an audio record mail-order business. In 1972, he opened a chain of record stores, Virgin Records, later known as Virgin Megastores. Branson's Virgin brand grew rapidly during the 1980s, as he set up Virgin Atlantic Airways and expanded the Virgin Records music label.

Branson is the 4th richest citizen of the United Kingdom and 254th richest person in the world, according to the Forbes 2011 list of billionaires, with an estimated net worth of US\$4.2 billion.

Early life

Branson was born in Blackthorn, Llanfyllter, a village child of barrister Edward James Branson (19 March 1918 – 19 March 2011) and Eve Huxley Branson (née Flindt). His grandfather, the Right Honourable Sir George Arthur Harwin Branson, was a judge of the High Court of Justice and a Privy Counsellor. Branson was educated at Scatcliffe School (now Bishopgate School) until the age of thirteen. He then attended Stone School until the age of sixteen. Branson has dyslexia and had poor academic performance as a student, but later discovered his ability to connect with others.

Career

Record business

Branson started his record business from the crypt of a church where he ran The Student. Branson advertised popular records in The Student Magazine and it was an overnight success. Trading under the name "Virgin", he sold records for considerably less than the "High Street" outlets, especially the chain W. H. Smith. The name "Virgin" was suggested by one of Branson's early employees because they were all new at business. At the time, many products were sold under restrictive marketing agreements that limited discounting, despite efforts in the 1950s and 1960s to limit so-called made price maintenance. In effect, Branson began the series of changes that led to large-scale discounting of record music.

Branson eventually started a record shop in Oxford Street in London. In 1971, Branson was questioned in connection with the selling of records in Virgin stores that had been declared export stock. The matter was never brought before a court and Branson agreed to repay any unpaid tax and a fine. Branson's mother Eve re-mortgaged the family home to help pay the settlement.

Earning enough money from his record store, Branson in 1972 launched the record label Virgin Records with Nik Powell and bought a country estate, in which he installed a recording studio. He leased out studio time to fledgling artists, including multi-instrumentalist Mike Oldfield, whose debut album Tubular Bells (1977) was Virgin Records' first release and a chart-topping best-seller.

Virgin signed such controversial bands as the Sex Pistols, which other companies were reluctant to sign. It also won praise for exposing the public to such album anti-gate music as Faust and Can. Virgin Records also introduced Culture Club to the music world. In the early 1980s, Virgin purchased the gay nightclub Heaven. In 1991, in a consortium with David Frost, Richard Branson made the unsuccessful bid for three ITV franchises under the CPV-TV name. The early 1980s also saw his only attempt as a producer—on the novelty record "Baa, Baa, Black Sheep", by Singing Sheep in association with Doug McLaren and Grace McDonald. The recording was a series of sheep baaing along to a drum machine produced track and even made the charts at number 47 in 1982.

In 1992, to keep his airline company afloat, Branson sold the Virgin label to EMI for £50 million. Branson says that he wept when the sale was completed since the record business had been the birth of the Virgin Empire. He later formed V2 Records to re-enter the music business.

After the so-called campaign of "dirty tricks", British Airways settled the case, giving £500,000 to Branson and a further £150,000 to his airline and had to pay legal fees of up to £1 million. Branson divided his compensation (the so-called "BA bonus") among his staff.

On 25 September 2004, Branson announced the signing of a deal under which a new space tourism company, Virgin Galactic, will license the technology behind SpaceShip One—funded by Microsoft co-founder Paul Allen and designed by legendary American aeronautical engineer and visionary Burt Rutan—to take paying passengers into suborbital space. Virgin Galactic (wholly owned by Virgin Group) plans to make flights available to the public with tickets priced at US\$100,000 using Scaled Composites White Knight Two.

Branson's next venture with the Virgin group is Virgin Fuel, which is set to respond to global warming and exploit the recent spike in fuel costs by offering a revolutionary, cheaper fuel for automobiles and, in the near future, aircraft. Branson has stated that he was formerly a global warming skeptic and was influenced in his decision by a breakfast meeting with Al Gore.

Branson has been lauded as a "transformational leader" in the management lexicon, with his maverick strategic and his stress on the Virgin Group as an organisation driven on informality and information, one that is bottom-heavy rather than strangled by top-level management.

World record attempts

Richard Branson made several world record-breaking attempts after 1985, when in the spirit of the Blue Bird he attempted the fastest Atlantic Ocean crossing. His first attempt in the "Virgin Atlantic Challenger" led to the boat capsizing in British waters and a rescue by RAF helicopter, which received wide media coverage. Some newspapers called for Branson to reimburse the government for the rescue cost. In 1986, in his "Virgin Atlantic Challenger II", with sailing expert Daniel McCarthy, he beat the record by two hours. A year later his hot air balloon "Virgin Atlantic

Flair" crossed the Atlantic. With its 2,200,000 cubic feet (62,000 m³), this was the largest hot air balloon, and the first to cross the Atlantic.

In January 1991, Branson crossed the Pacific from Japan to Arctic Canada, 8,700 miles (14,000 km), in a balloon of 2,600,000 cubic feet (74,000 m³). This broke the record, with a speed of 243 miles per hour (394 km/h).

Between 1995 and 1998 Branson, Per Lindstrand and Steve Fossett made attempts to circumnavigate the globe by balloon. In late 1998 they made a record-breaking flight from Moscow to Hawaii but were unable to complete a global flight before Bertrand Picard and Brian Jones in Breitling Orbiter 3 in March 1999.

In March 2004, Branson set a record by travelling from Dover to Calais in a Gibbs Aquada in 1 hour, 40 minutes and 6 seconds, the fastest crossing of the English Channel in an amphibious vehicle. The previous record of six hours was set by two Frenchmen. The test of Top Gear, Jimmy Clarkon, James May and Richard Hammond, attempted to break this record in an amphibious vehicle which they had constructed and, while successfully crossing the channel, did not break Branson's record.

In September 2008 Branson and his children made an unsuccessful attempt at an Eastward record crossing of the Atlantic ocean under sail in the 99 feet (30 m) ship Virgin Money. The boat, also known as Speedboat, is owned by NYCC member Aley Jackson, who was a co-skipper on this passage, with Branson and Mike Sanderson. After 2 days, 4 hours, 45 minutes and 19 seconds (147 miles), and seas of 40 feet (12 m), a "monster wave" destroyed the speedboat, washed a sea-man 34-foot overboard and severely ripped the mast. The crew eventually continued to St. George's, Bermuda. In March 2010 Richard tried for the world record of putting a round of golf in the dark at the Black Light Mini Golf in The Ducklands, Melbourne, Australia. He succeeded in getting 41 on the par 43 course.
