Возможности и преимущества

Что такое eReserve?

- **eReserve** - это уникальная возможность перевести учебные *печатные* материалы, которые Вы используете в рамках преподаваемых курсов, в *электронный* (цифровой) формат.
- Все оцифрованные материалы размещаются специалистами Библиотеки в системе e-Course, что позволяет студентам, получить доступ к учебным ресурсам в **любое время, в любом месте, в течение семестра**.
- Резервирование материалов позволяет обеспечить студентов определенных курсов материалами, которые имеются в библиотеке, но в недостаточном количестве.
- Сервис **eReserve** также предоставляет возможность разместить в e-Course все Ваши учебные материалы, которые находятся в Системе файлов и папок АУЦА.

Какие ресурсы могут быть размещены в системе eReserve?

- **Печатные копии** (книги, статьи из журналов);
- **Электронные ресурсы** (в т.ч. в формате .doc, .pdf, .ppt, .jpg, .xls);
- **Ссылки на веб-ресурсы** (из электронных баз данных: Ebrary, EBSCO, JSTOR и т.д.)
