





finding aid

- A finding aid is a document containing detailed information about a specific collection of papers or records within an archive. The finding aid for a collection is usually compiled by an archivist or librarian during archival processing. Finding aids are a concept dating back to ancient **Sumer**'s clay tablet culture. In more recent times, finding aids were usually written or, later, printed on paper. Finding aids today can be created in various electronic and print formats, including word processor document, spreadsheet, database, paper list, index cards, etc. The standard machine-readable format for manuscript collection finding aids, widely used in the United States, England, Canada, and Australia, is **Encoded Archival Description**
