

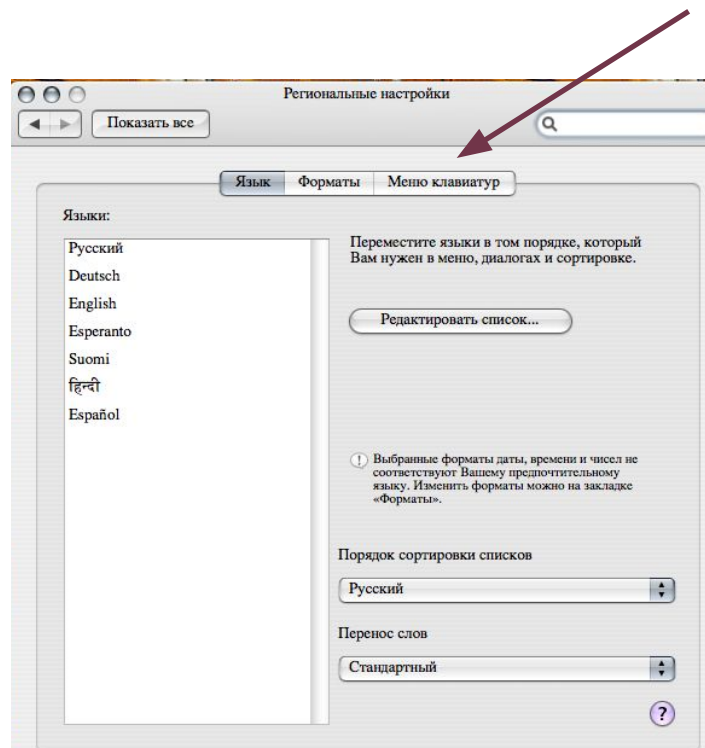

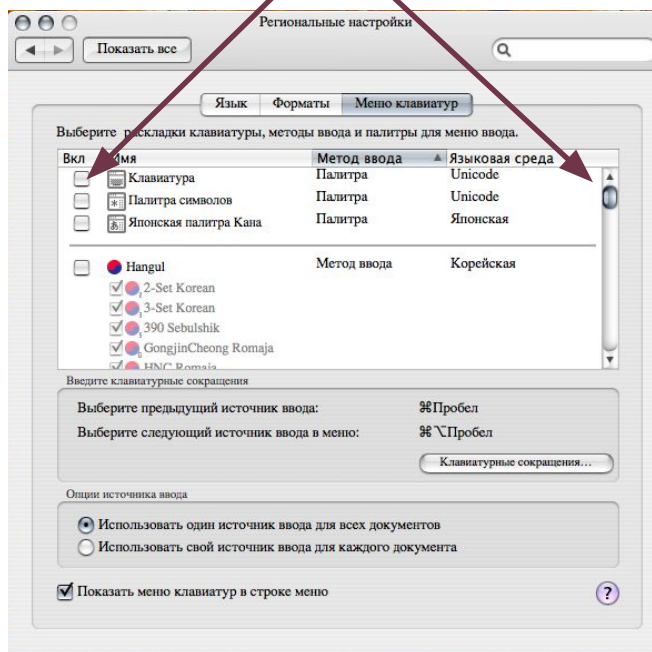

## 1. System Settings: Regional Options: Input Menu



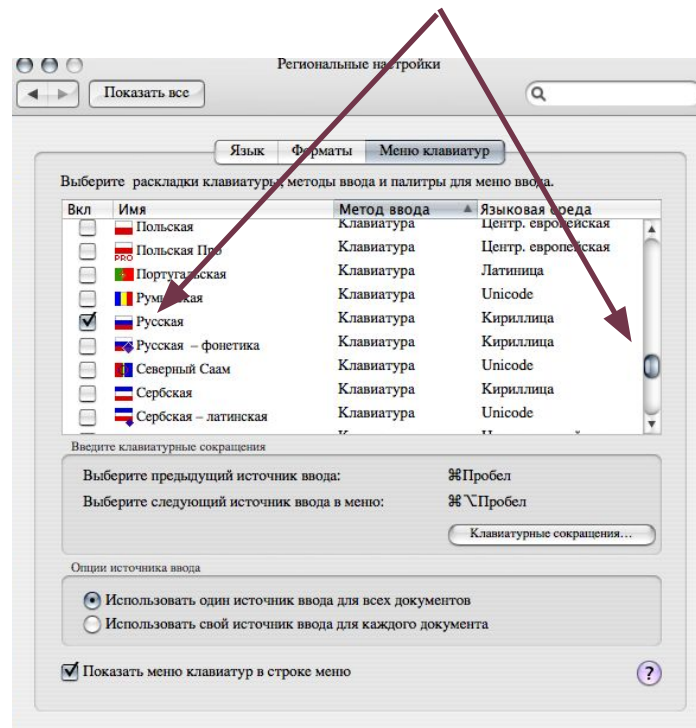

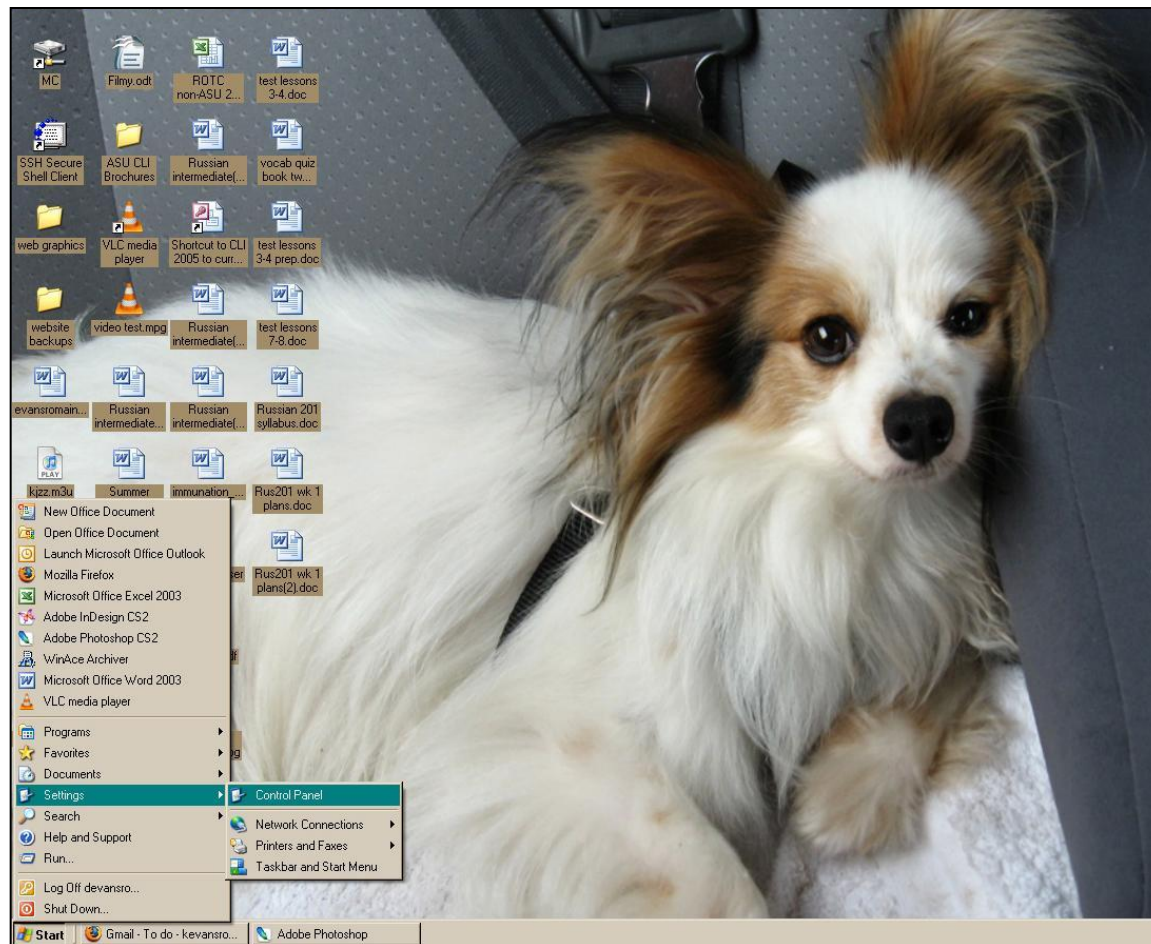

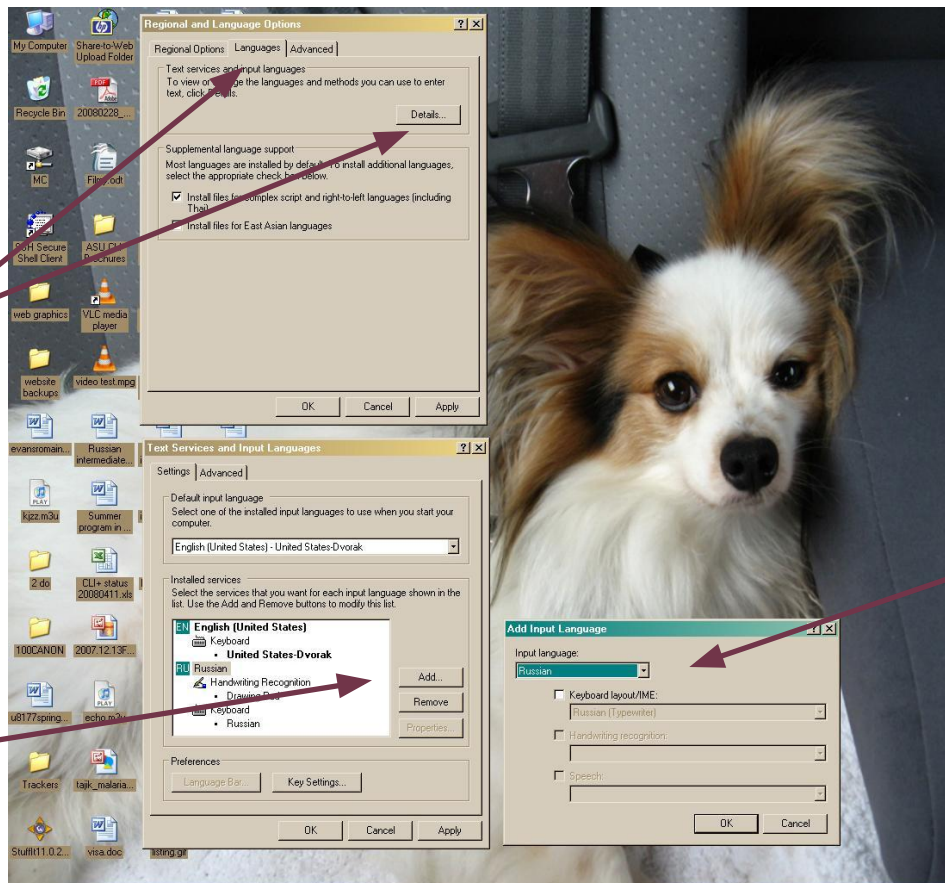

button

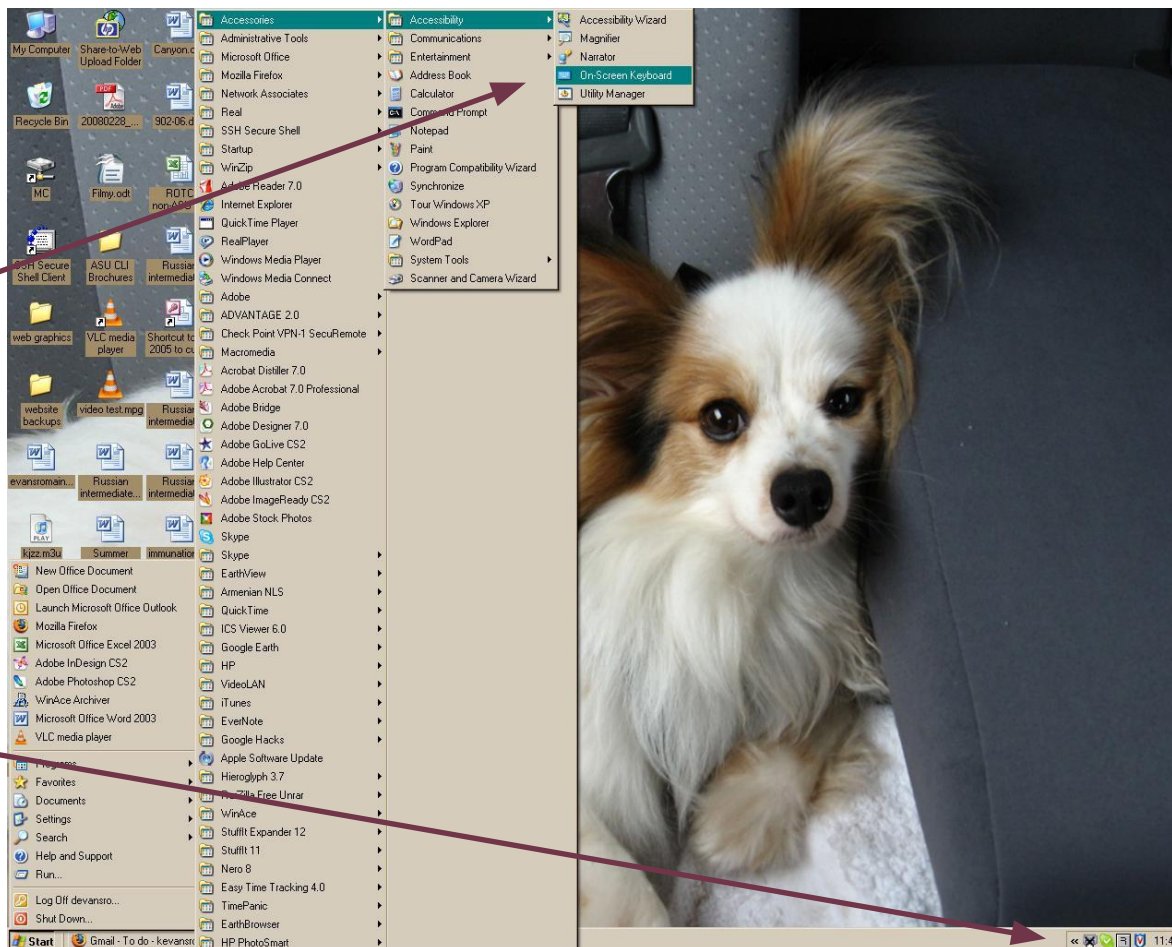

Russian

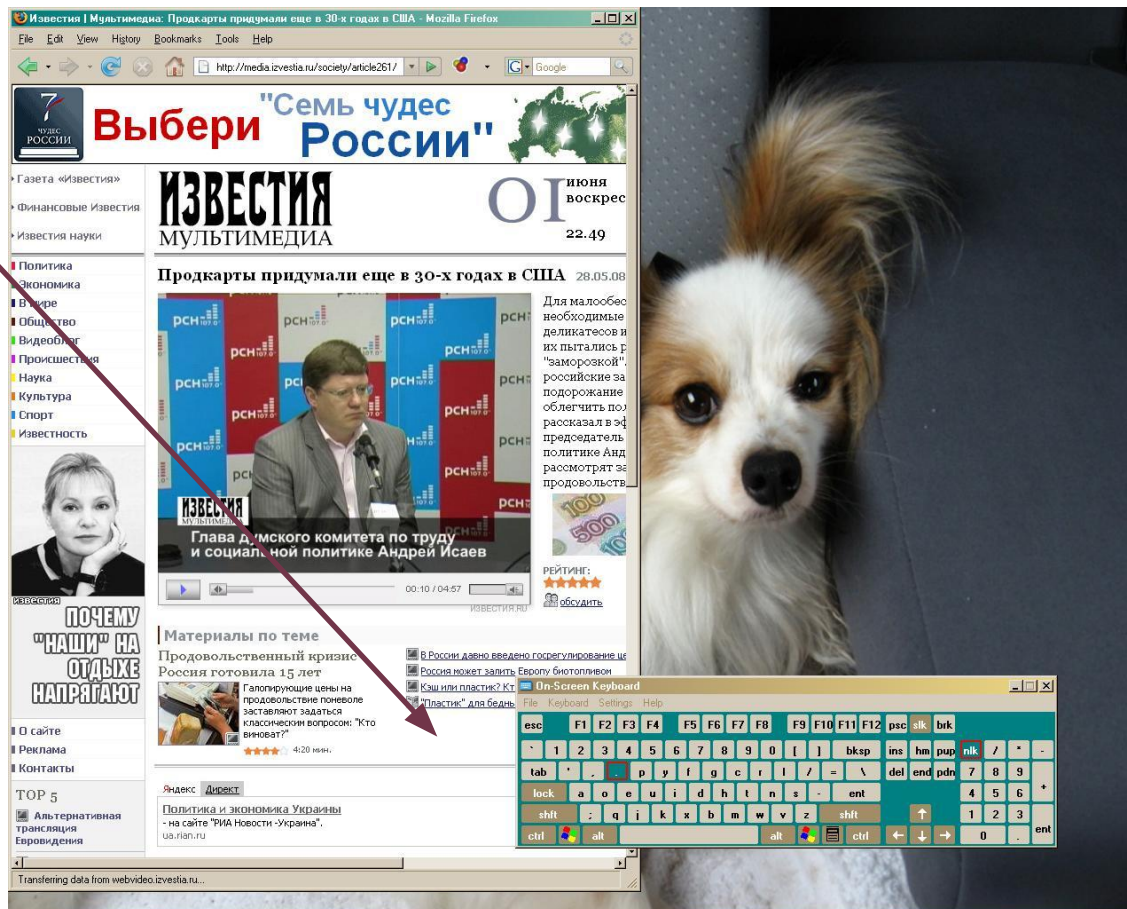




# Russian keyboard for Windows XP

5. On-screen keyboard sits on TOP of other applications (so it is visible no matter what you are doing)

NOTE: Each window can have its own language setting. You may have to click into each one then switch to Russian.



## Russian keyboards in the computing commons
