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Critical reading

Literal - what is actually stated

Interpretive - what is implied

Evaluative - when what was meant by what was stated is actually applied to concepts or ideas that go beyond what was discussed

Appreciative - more abstract and based on a deeper understanding of the material in question

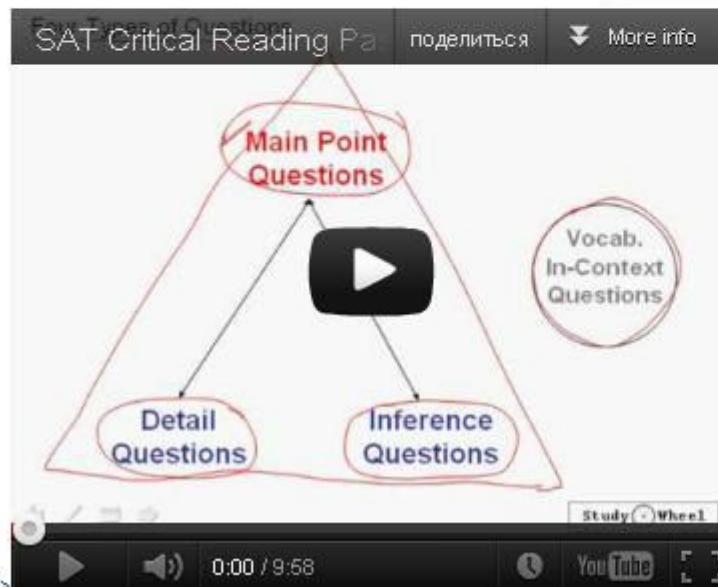
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Module 2 - “critical reading” notion

All the preceding reading techniques have been concerned with various aspects of reading to understand. However, at an academic level, there is more to reading than just understanding the author's intentions, but conceiving the text from some angle. That is why we'll discuss *critical reading* which is an analytic activity. To the critical reader, any single fact is not the facts, one individual's "take" on the subject matter. Critical readers thus recognize not only *what* a text says, but also *how* that text portrays the subject matter. While critical reading involves several modes of analysis by the subject matter of the discussion:

- What a text says – restatement – talks about the same topic as the original text
- What a text does – description – discusses aspects of the discussion itself
- What a text means – interpretation – analyzes the text and asserts a meaning for the text as a whole
