PICCADILLY CIRCUS




Piccadilly

world.


WESTMINSTER ABBEY

TOWER BRIDGE




It was built in 1804. It is next to the Tower of London. It is one of the famous bridges across the Thames. It opens and ships go up and down the River Thames.
