## Ukraine's Poroshenko hails 'start of Russia dialogue'

Ukrainian President-elect Petro Poroshenko has hailed a meeting with Russia's Vladimir Putin as a start of dialogue over the east

<u>Ilkraino crisis</u>



Mr. Poroshenko, who is to be inaugurated on Saturday, said he expected to be recognized soon by Moscow and that talks would start on Sunday.

Mr. Putin welcomed Kiev's approach, but said an immediate ceasefire was needed before negotiation began.

Separately US President Barack Obama spoke to Mr. Putin of the need to de-escalate the situation in eastern Ukraine.
