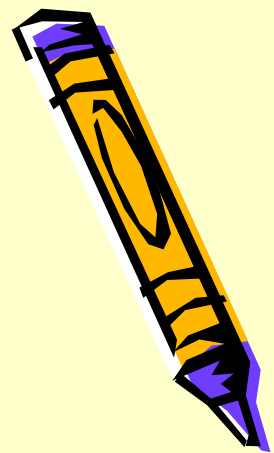


How Spot learns to bark

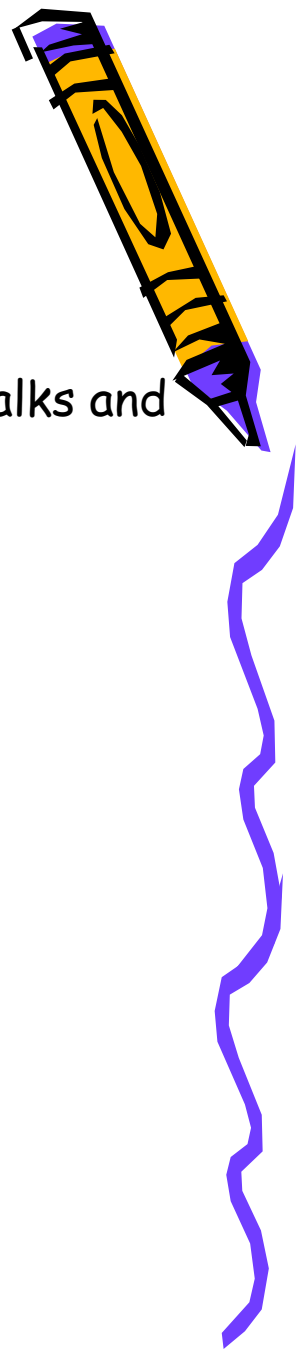




This is our little puppy Spot. It is small. It likes its house and it likes to walk in the garden. It can run, jump, play with other animals.

Cock. Say "Cock-a-doodle-doo".

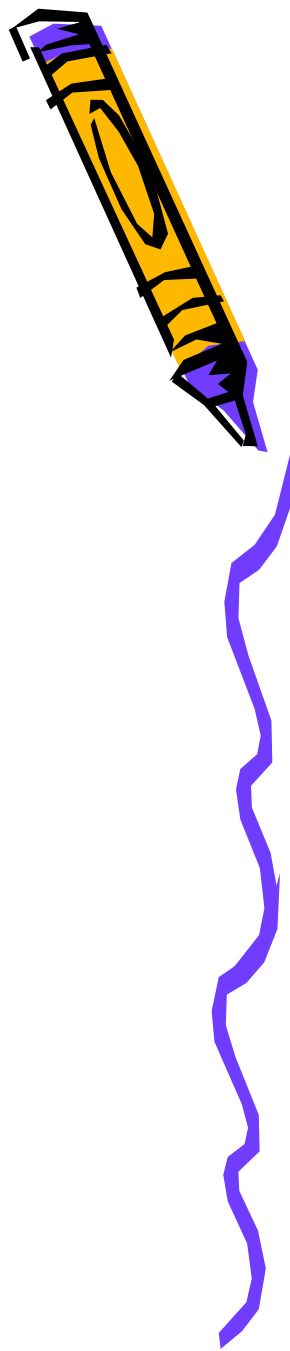
Spot. Oh, no. That is what the Cock says. Little dogs bark!

Cat. Mew-mew.

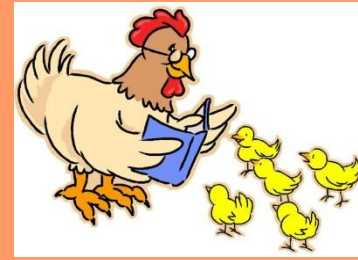
Spot. Bow-wow, bow-wow.
