Life and Work



Childhood

- 1890, February 10 (January 29)
Born in Moscow, Boris Pasternak. His father - an artist Leonid Osipovich Pasternak, his mother - a pianist Rosalie Isidorovna, nee Kaufman.

Leonid Osipovich Pasternak-Russian painter and graphic artist, a master of genre scenes and book illustrations; teacher.

universities

- 1901, August
He entered the second class of Moscow the fifth high school.
- 1908, May
The end of high school with a gold medal.
- August
Entered the law faculty of Moscow University. In parallel, even in high school pass ratecomposer on the program Conservatory, preparing to take an external examination.
- 1909, May
Translated into philosophical Department of History and Philology of the University.

1913 - the decision to become a poet

- April
The first publication of poems Boris Pasternak in a collective book "Lyrics." In the same year he graduated from University with the title of candidate of philosophy at Moscow University.
- December
Work on the collection of poems "The Twin in the Clouds."

Creativity 20s

- 1917
The revolution in Russia, Boris Pasternak was working on a book, "My sister - my life."
- 1917-1918
Work on the story "Childhood grommet."
- 1921
Check out the parents in Berlin.

Creativity 30s

- 1922
His marriage to artist Evgenia Lurie; start corresponding Pasternak and Marina Tsvetaeva, while living in France.
- January
It turns out a book of poems, "My sister - my life."
- 1922-1923
Staying in Germany, participated in the literary life of Berlin, here comes a book of poems, "Themes and Variations" (January 1923).
- 1924
In the journal "LEF" is printed the poem "High disease", in which Boris Pasternak tries to express his understanding of the October Revolution.

The War Years

- **1941**
 - Translated and published the "Hamlet", begins work on the translation of "Romeo and Juliet.«
- **July-August**
 - Evacuation of the family in Chistopol, the first "war" poems.
- **1943**
 - As part of the writer Boris Pasternak team is sent to the Bryansk Front.
- **1945**
 - It turns out the last book of poetry lifetime Boris Pasternak "Selected poems".

In an atmosphere of repression

- **1945-1955**

Work on the novel "Doctor Zhivago".

October

The Last Days of the poet

- **1959**

In the British newspaper published a poem, "Nobel Prize", followed by Boris Pasternak called to the Attorney-General RA Rudenko, faces charges of treason and prohibit meetings with foreigners.

- **1960, February 10**

Seventieth anniversary of the writer. He begins work on the play "Blind Beauty".

- **May 30**

Boris Pasternak died at his dacha in Peredelkino.
