Structure

Present Simple

+ ☺ + V(s/es)

- ☺ + don't/doesn't + V

? (Wh-) + do/does + ☺ + V?

Present Continuous

+ ☺ + am/is/are + Ving

- ☺ + am not/isn't/aren't + Ving

? (Wh-) + am/is/are + ☺ + Ving?

Signal words

Present Simple

- Always
- Usually
- Often
- Sometimes
- Rarely
- Seldom
- Hardly ever
- Never
- Every

Present Continuous

- Now
- At the moment
- Today
- This... (week, month)
- Listen!/Look!

Don't use in Present Continuous:

- Like
- Love
- Hate
- Prefer
- Want



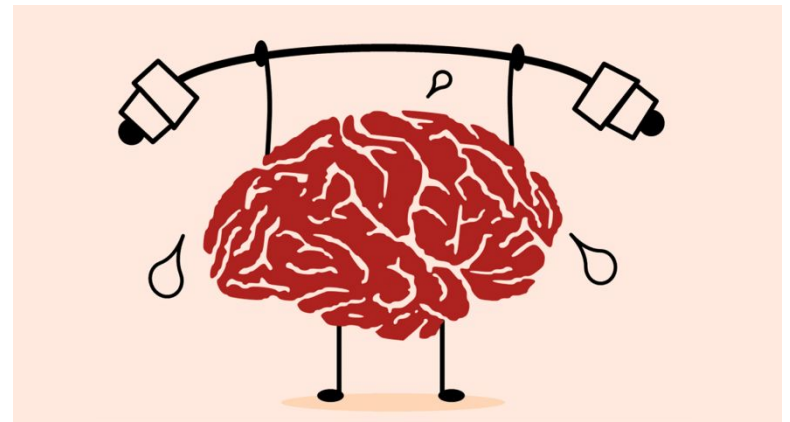
Don't use in Present Continuous:

- Hear
- Smell
- Taste
- Feel



Don't use in Present Continuous:

- Think
- Understand
- Believe
- Know



Don't use in Present Continuous:

- Have
- Belong
- Mean
- Cost
