s

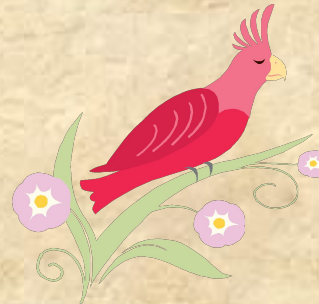
We see some

s in the yard.

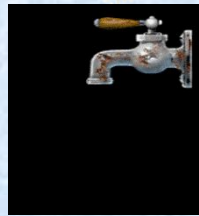
