
- Print, laminate, and cut out the cards.
- 2 When ready to play, distribute one card to each child. If you have less than 24 students, you may want to give a few students more than one card or include yourself in distribution.
- 3 Play begins when the student with the first card reads his card. Students must listen for the first word/picture on their cards.
- 4 When a student hears his word/picture read, he then reads his card.


Play continues until the last card is read.

My students like to exchange cards with friends and play the game 2 to 3 times.


























































