The message of the book

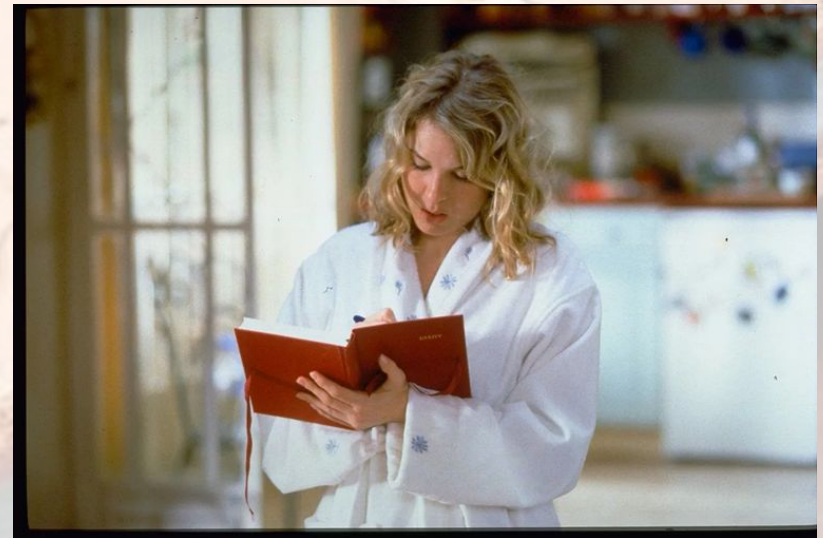
- Women should have dignity.
