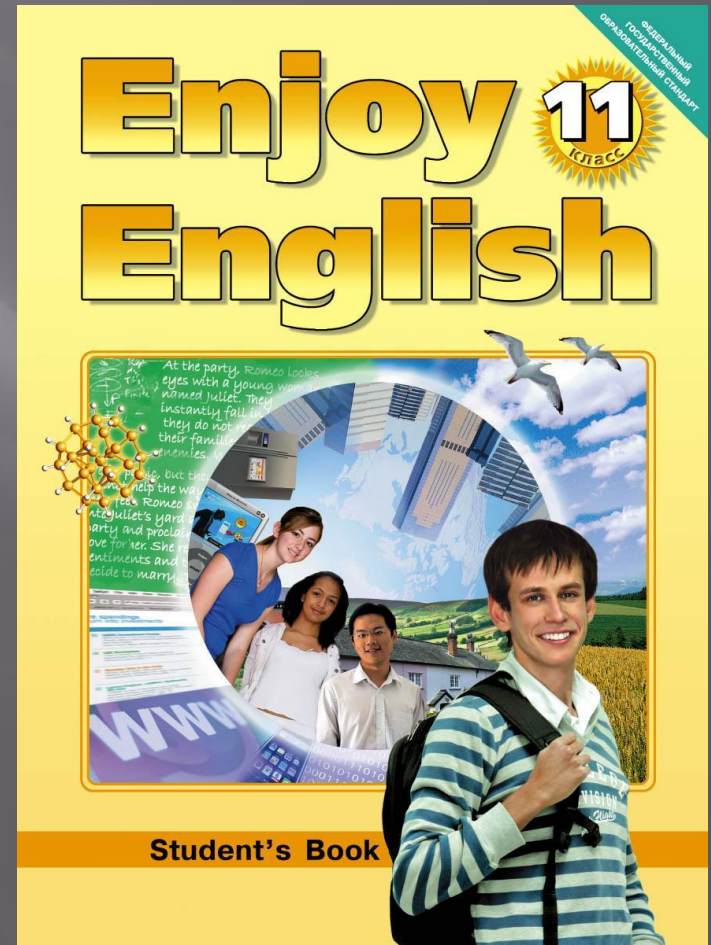
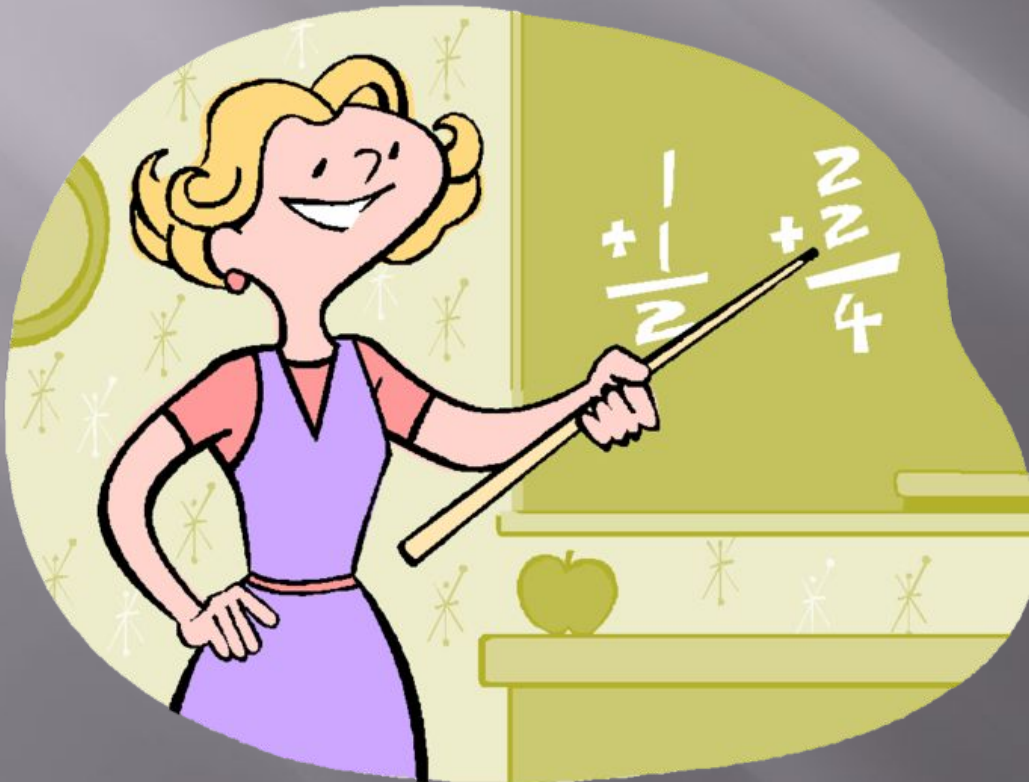

happy, on the other not so much**



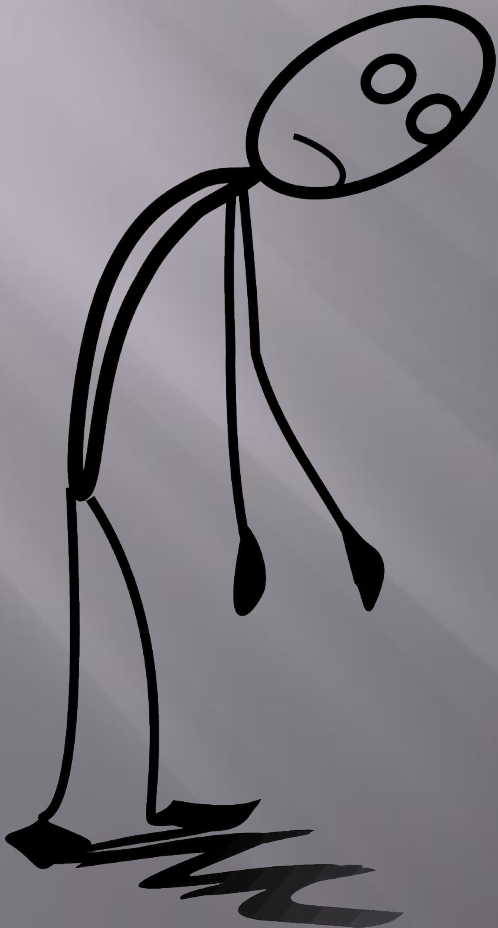

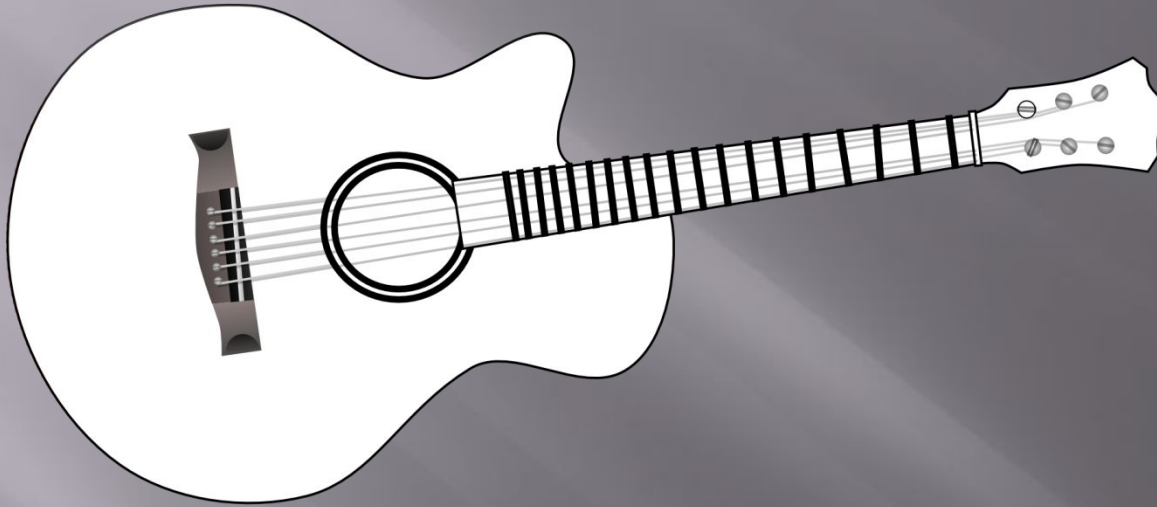
