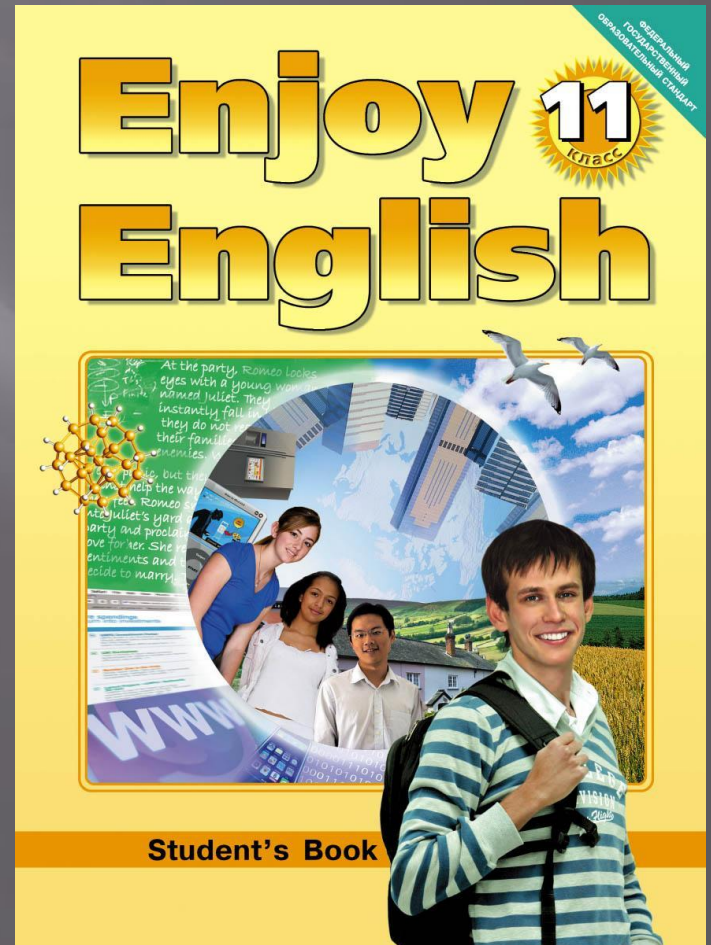
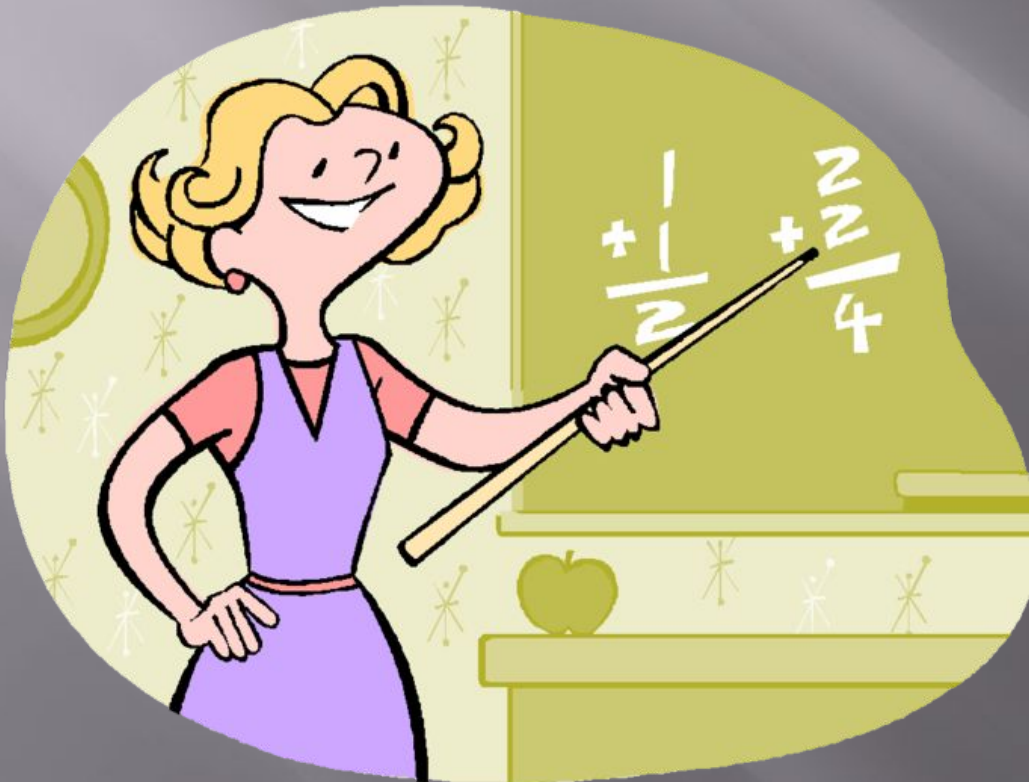

happy,on the other not so much**



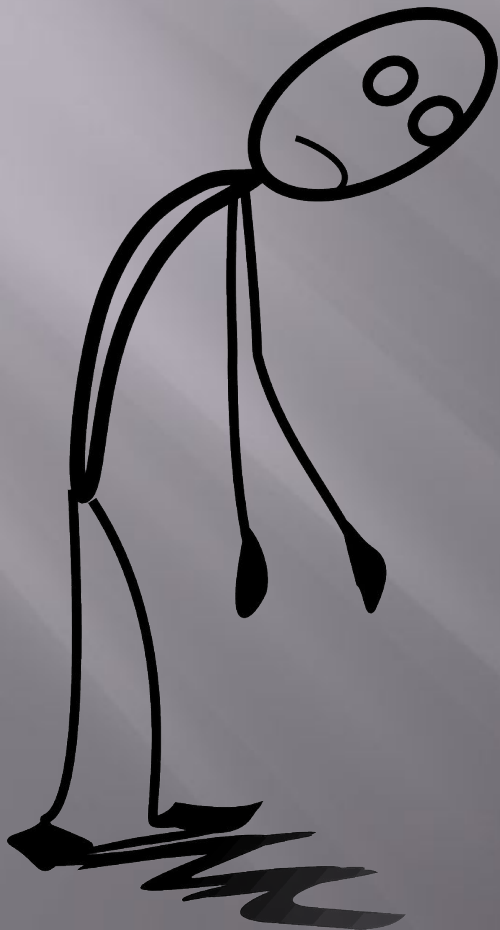

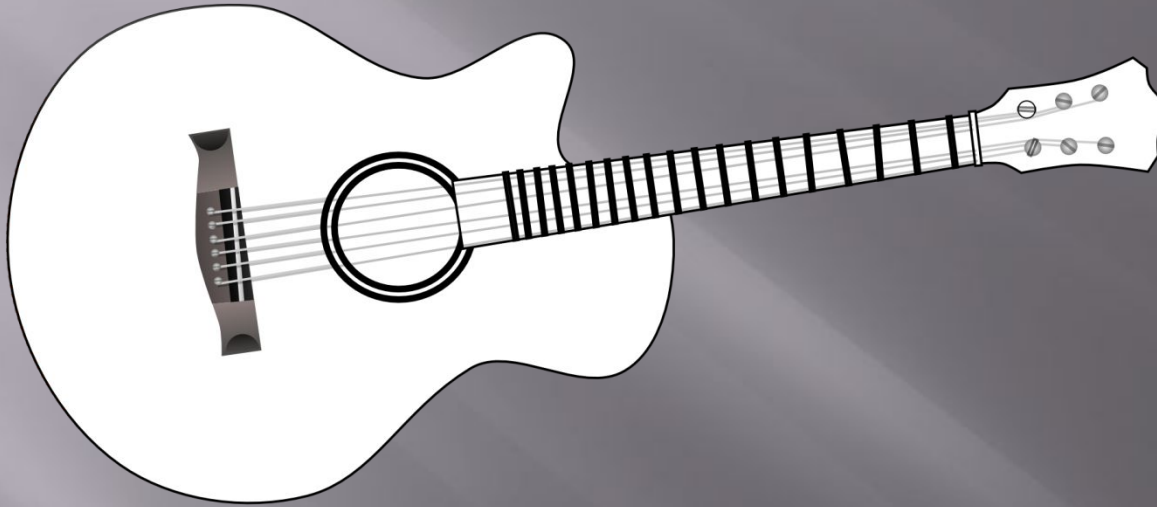
