really have time for it. There's a small bakery near my office. I usually buy a croissant or something else there and eat it for breakfast.

I leave home at half past 7. I go to work by car. It takes me about 20 minutes to get there. There's always a traffic jam on the way to work. As I told you I buy something to eat at the bakery.

I start working at 8. My assistant always tells me what programmes I have that day. First I usually read my letters and e-mails. Then I answer them with my secretary.

we order it. We always make a salad, too. They have to be at home by 3 pm.


When my children aren't with me I just relax or work a bit if it's necessary. I don't have to do any
