really have time for it. There's a small bakery near my office. I usually buy a croissant or something else there and eat it for breakfast.

I leave home at half past 7. I go to work by car. It takes me about 20 minutes to get there. There's always a traffic jam on the way to work. As I told you I buy something to eat at the bakery.

I start working at 8. My assistant always tells me what programmes I have that day. First I usually read my letters and e-mails. Then I answer them with my secretary.

On Mondays I have a meeting with the managers of my car wash saloons at 10 am. We discuss the previous week and the occurring problems.

We have lunch from 12 to half past 12, but if I have a business lunch, it takes more time.

On Wednesday I always have a meeting with the accountant after lunch. We discuss the receipts and expenses, the sudden expenses, etc.

What else do I do? If we want to employ someone, I interview the applicants and choose the best one of them. I look for new possibilities in Hungary and abroad. I manage the company.

I finish work at about 5 or 6 pm. On Fridays I play tennis with my friend, John. I have dinner at home. I always order something because I can't cook. In the evening I usually read a book or watch TV. Sometimes I switch on the computer and surf the net or play online games. I have a bath at 10 and go to bed at midnight.

The weekends are a bit different. I meet my children every other weekend. On Saturday, I get up at 6 and have a shower, drink my coffee, clean my teeth and get dressed. I pick my children up at quarter past 8. We go shopping and buy something for breakfast and dinner. We have breakfast at half past 9 then play a board game or go to a sports centre where we play squash or bowling. We usually have lunch where my children want or order something. In the afternoons we watch a film or go to the cinema. At 7 pm we have dinner at home. My children, Anna and David have a bath after dinner and clean their teeth. I always read them a story before going to sleep. They go to bed at 9 and then I have a bath and fall asleep at 11.

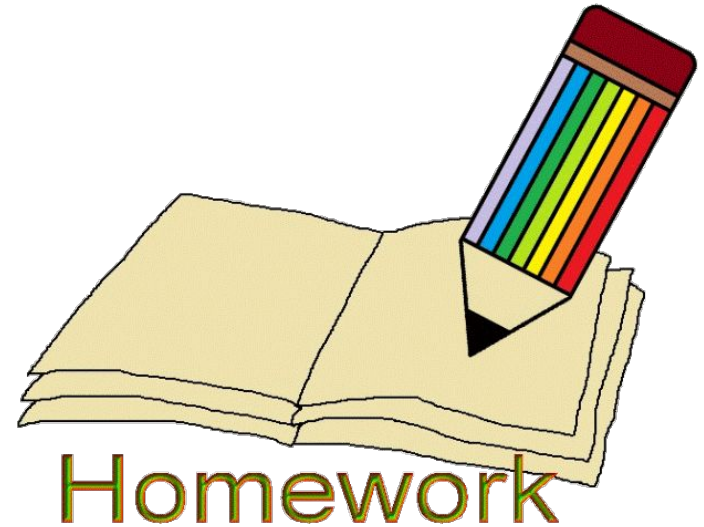
I take them home on Sunday afternoon. We get up at 8 am and have breakfast. We clean our teeth and get dressed. In the morning they do their homework and I read a book. We have lunch at noon. We always eat a pizza. If we have all the ingredients, we prepare it but sometimes we order it. We always make a salad, too.

They have to be at home by 3 pm.

When my children aren't with me I just relax or work a bit if it's necessary. I don't have to do any housework because there's a charwoman who does it. I rarely date with a woman but I don't really want to have a serious relationship.
