

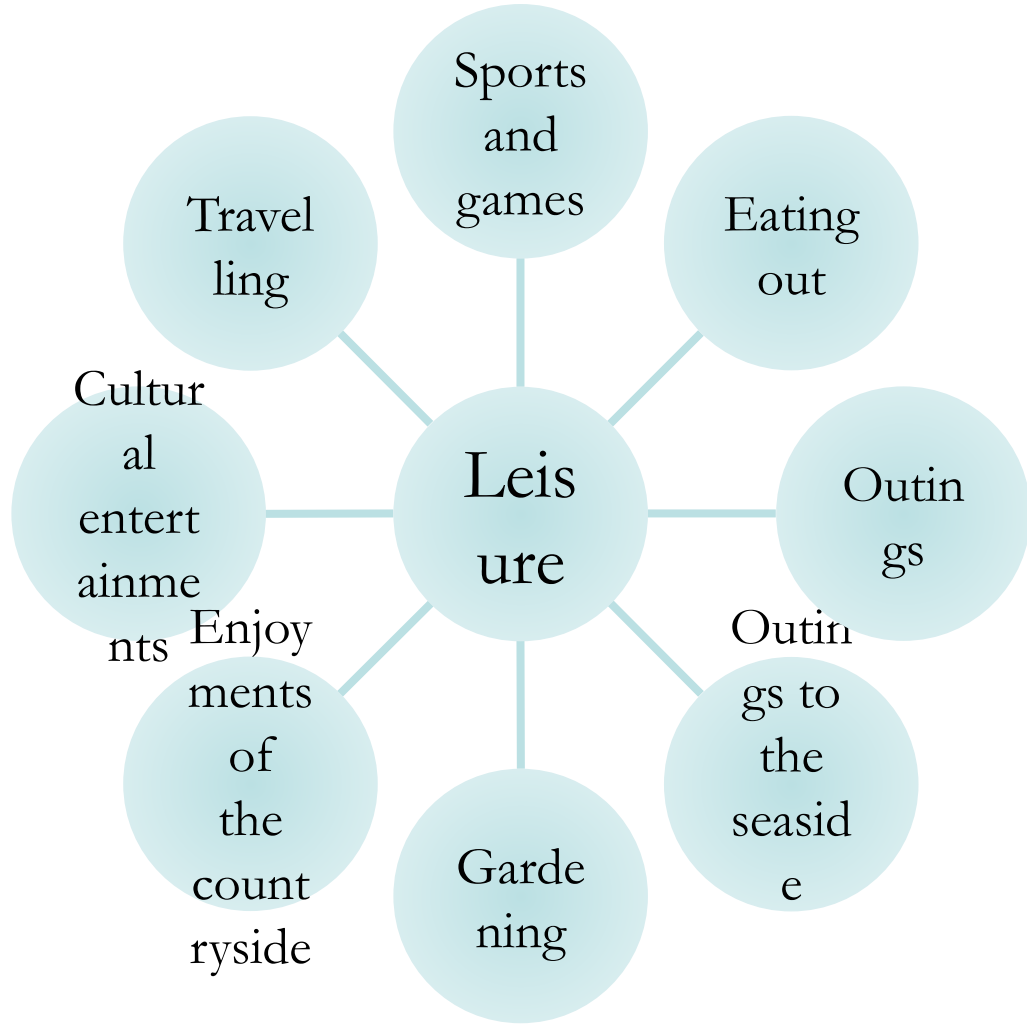

Laws about pubs.

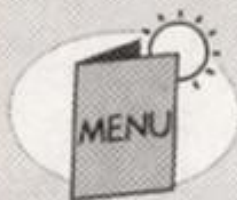
- Pubs can only sell alcohol at certain times.
- Children under 14 can't go into bars where drinks are served. However it is possible to take children to quite a lot of pubs to have a meal.
- People under 18 can't buy or drink alcohol in pubs.
- People under 18 are not allowed to play machines that give money as prizes – in pubs or in any other place.

PUB SIGNS TO NOTE



1 Families Welcome

Children when accompanied by an adult are welcome in areas designated for families.



2 Lunch Time Menu

A varied selection of food is available during the lunch time period.



3 Evening Menu

Food is available during the evening ranging from hot snacks to A La Carte menus.



4 Beer Garden

External seating is available within the pub, garden and/or grounds.



5 Car Park

Parking facilities are available for customers during opening hours.



6 All Day Opening

Pubs displaying this symbol do not close between lunch and evening.
