<b>Единственное число</b> (один человек или животное) существительное + 's	Nick's dog boy's bicycle sister's room	Goofy's bone tiger's tail lion's cage
<b>Множественное число</b> (два и больше людей или животных) существительное + s'	boys' bicycles friends' toys sisters' dresses	dogs' bones tigers' paws lions' cages
