Lady Gaga and Cyndi Lauper launched their own lipstick lines together with the world brand of cosmetics MAC - Viva Glam Gaga Lipstick and Viva Glam Cyndi Lipstick. Both lipsticks retail for \$35 each, with every cent going directly towards the MAC AIDS Fund which has raised more than US\$160 million in the fight against HIV/AIDS.



Born This Way Foundation

In 2012, Gaga launched the Born This Way Foundation (BTWF), a non-profit organization that focuses on empowerment of young people. That fund saves a thousand teenagers from desperate situations. Lady Gaga's mom is the manager of this fund.
