First Conditional

- *Выражает реальное или возможное условие в настоящем или будущем*

If + Present Simple, Simple Future (will + Infinitive)

Catch a cold

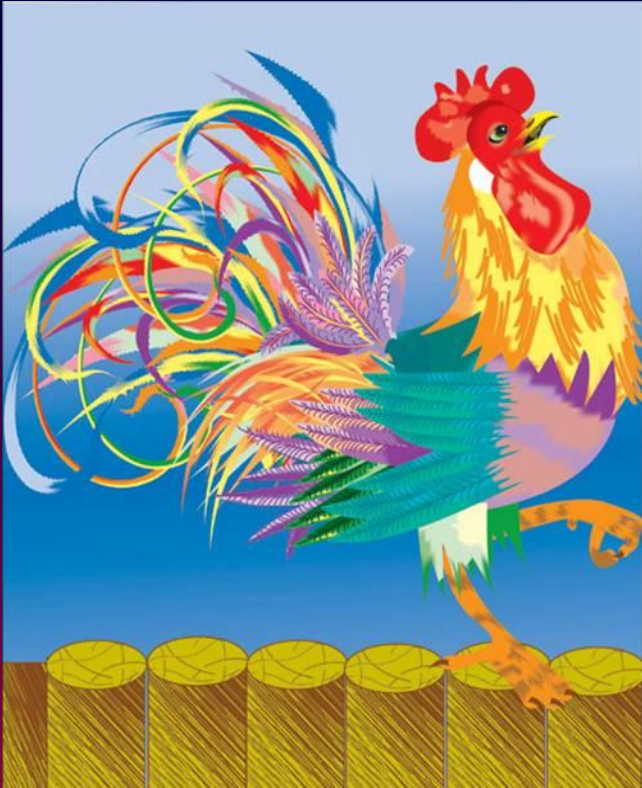

Second Conditional

- *Выражает нереальное или воображаемое условие в настоящем или будущем*

If + Past Simple, would + Infinitive

If ifs and ands were pots and pans...

- If someone gave you \$100, what would you buy?
- If you won a ticket for anywhere in the world, where would you go?
- If you lost your home key, what would you do?
- If you met a famous pop star, what would you say to him/her?
- If you saw someone robbing a bank, what would you do?

Third Conditional

- *Выражает нереальную ситуацию, относящуюся к прошлому, которая не произошла, упущенную возможность*

If + Past Perfect, would + Present Perfect

Make the sentences

- Sally ate a lot of sweets. Because of this she did not finish her dinner.
- Joe did not do his homework. As a result, his teacher was angry.
- Linda lost her purse so she didn't buy Sally a birthday present.
- The traffic was terrible and Sally arrived home late.
