Comparatives

The power of grammar

When we compare things, we use **comparative forms**. We change the form of the adjective and add the word **than**.

- ▶ Today is **hotter than** yesterday.
- ▶ This test is **more difficult than** the last one.
- ▶ She seems **happier than** before.

For adjectives with one syllable, add -er .	long	long er
For adjectives that end in one vowel followed by a consonant, double the consonant. Then add -er .	hot	hot ter
For adjectives that end in y, change y to i and add -er .	happy	happi er
For adjectives with two or more syllables, just write more before the adjective.	difficult	more difficult
Irregular Forms	good bad	better worse



We can also make comparative forms of adverbs.

- ▶ Sara sings **more beautifully than** Amy.
- ▶ Mike runs **faster than** John.
- ▶ We played **worse than** I imagined.

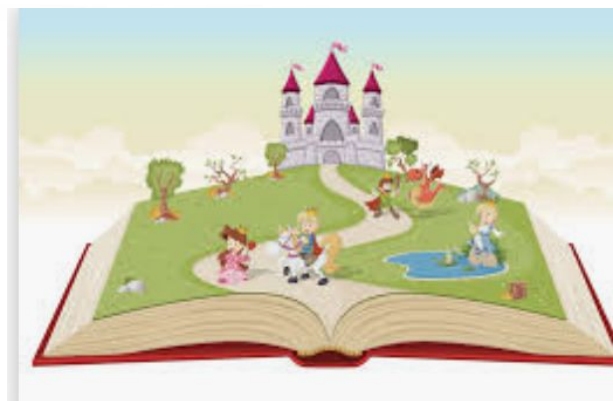

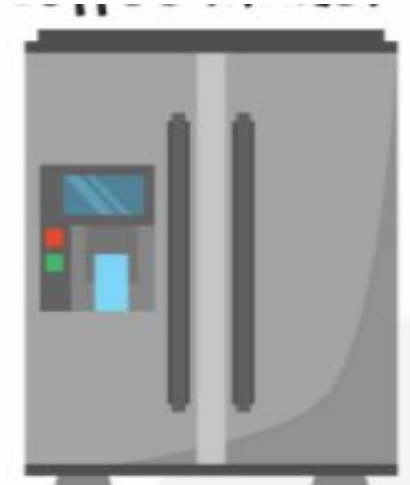
