

# The power of grammar

When we compare things, we use **comparative forms**. We change the form of the adjective and add the word **than**.

- Today is hotter than yesterday.
- This test is more difficult than the last one.
- She seems happier than before.

For adjectives with one syllable, add <b>-er.</b>	long	longer
For adjectives that end in one vowel followed by a consonant, double the consonant. Then add <b>-er</b> .	hot	hotter
For adjectives that end in y, change y to i and add <b>-er</b> .	happy	happi <mark>er</mark>
For adjectives with two or more syllables, just write <b>more</b> before the adjective.	difficult	more difficult
Irregular Forms	good bad	better worse



We can also make comparative forms of adverbs.

- Sara sings more beautifully than Amy.
- Mike runs faster than John.
- We played worse than I imagined.






