## TEDIOUS

Too long, slow, or dull  
*For example: It really was a tedious journey.*

## DULL

Lacking interest or excitement  
*For example: If it's dull and lifeless, your reader will surely move on.*

Causing one to feel bored or annoyed  
*For example: His speech was quite tiresome.*

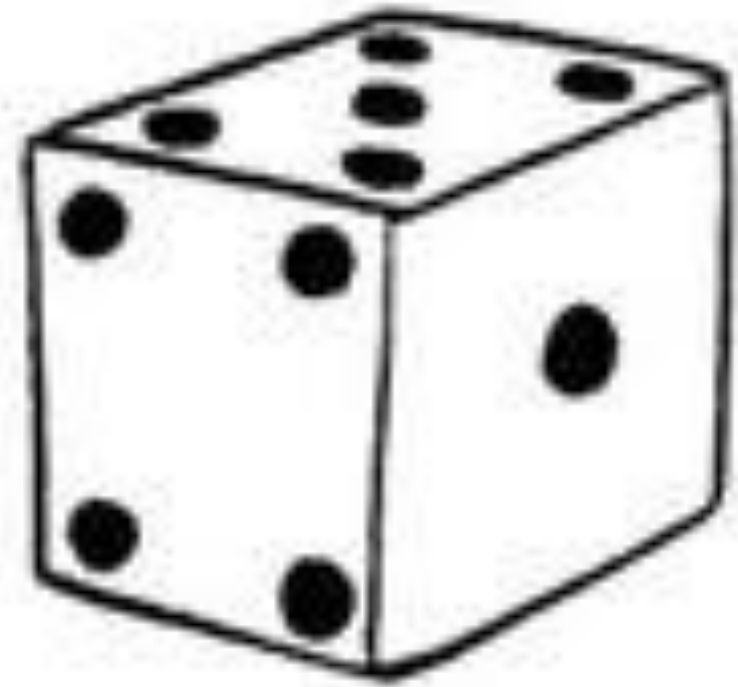

# Слова-маркеры Present Perfect

- **just** – только что
- **already** – уже
- **yet** – уже, еще (в отрицаниях и вопросах)
- **this week (month, year)** – на этой неделе
- **today** - сегодня
- **recently** - недавно
- **lately** – в последнее время
- **ever** – когда-либо
- **Never-** – никогда
- **so far** – пока что
- **for 10 years** – в течении 10 лет
- **since 2015** – с 2015 года
- **once, twice, 10 times** –один раз, дважды, 10 раз
- **up to now, till now** – до настоящего момента
- **for a long time** – в течении долгого времени

# Слова-маркеры Past Simple

- **Yesterday** – вчера
- **last week, month, year** – на прошлой неделе, в прошлом месяце, в прошлом году
- **..5 years ago** – 5 лет назад
- **when I was...** – когда я был..
- **in 1990** – в 1990 году

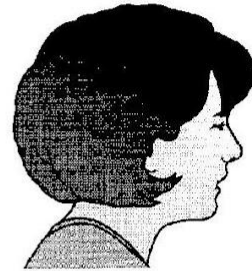

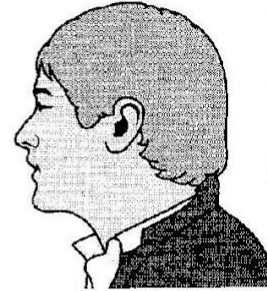
