Monument to processed cheese “Druzhba”

- A monument based on Krylov's fable "The Crow and the Fox" was created. Irreconcilable antagonists, a crow and a fox, sitting hugging each other on a stump, gently squeeze a processed cheese. According to the authors, the monument is a symbol of peace and harmony.



Monument to chocolate. Pokrov

- The monument is a three-meter bronze figure of a fairy tale fairy, which seems to be created from a chocolate bar. The fairy also holds a chocolate bar in her hands. She decorated a small picturesque square near the Pokrovsky Chocolate Museum.



Monument to the kitten from Lizyukov Street. Voronezh

- It is deservedly considered one of the attractions of Voronezh, dedicated to the favorite characters of the animated film of the same name. The sculpture was installed in 2003. Kitty Vasya is the first sculpture of a cartoon character in our country and the third monument in the world to a cartoon character.



Monument to the St. Petersburg Angel

- Not far from the Fontanka Embankment in the Izmailovsky Garden, an angel sits on a bench: in one hand he holds a book – in the other an open umbrella. Thus, the famous puppet master Roman Shustrov showed a certain St. Petersburg image of an old man - namely, intellectuals at a respectable age with a clear mind and a fine mental organization, who at one time survived the horrors of social cataclysms and kept peace in their souls, helping to rebuild the city.
