Origin of the name



The word York derives from the Latinised name for the city, variously rendered as Eboracum, Eburacum or Eburaci. The first mention of York by this name is dated to circa 95–104 AD.

The form York was first recorded in the 13th century. Many company and place names, such as the Ebor race meeting, refer to the Roman name.

Architecture

York Minster, the largest Gothic cathedral in Northern Europe. York Castle, a complex of buildings ranging from the medieval Clifford's Tower to the 20th century entrance to the York Castle Museum. York's centre is enclosed by the city's medieval walls, which are a popular walk. A feature of central York is the Snickelways, narrow pedestrian routes
