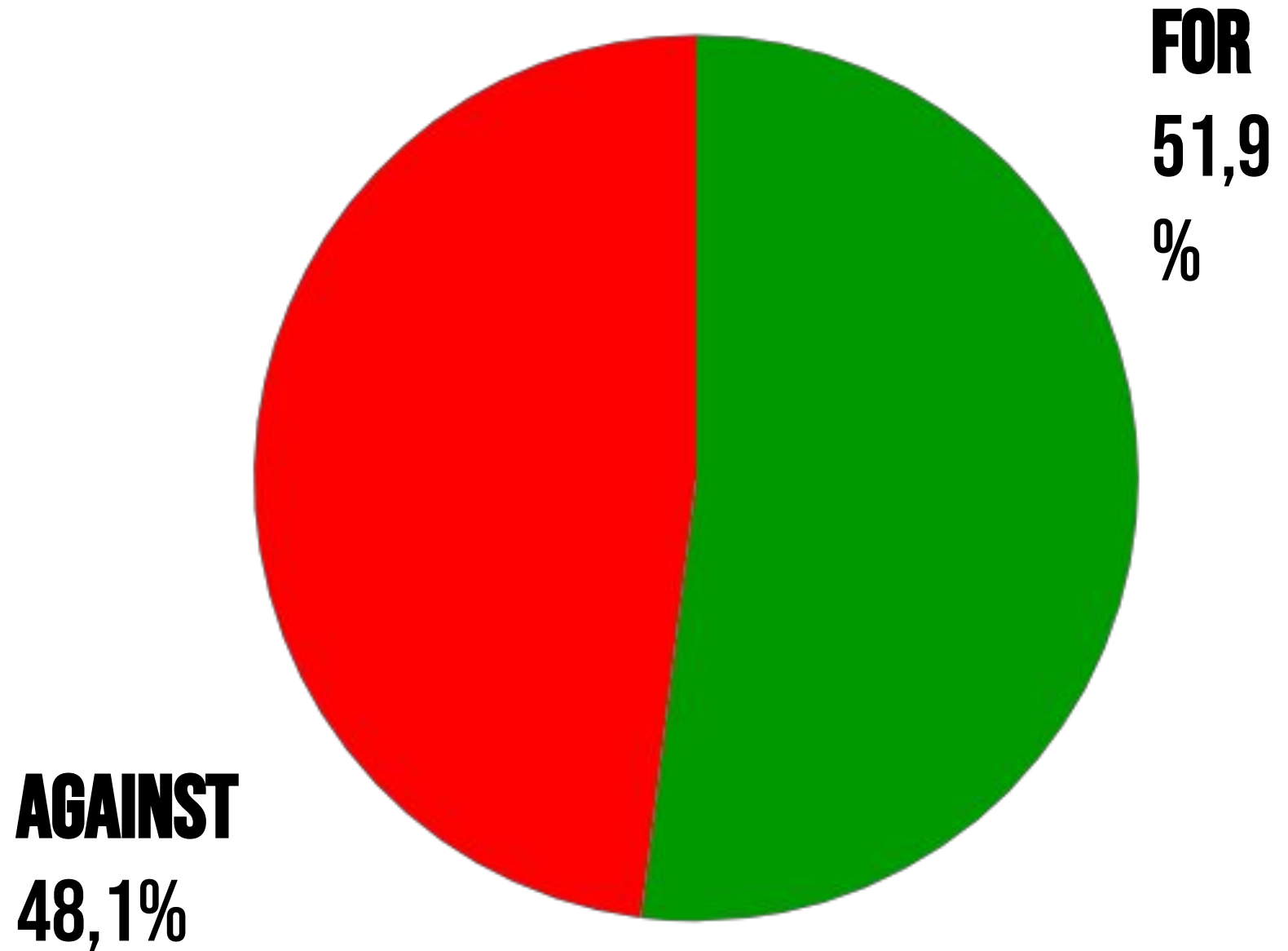

## **REASONS FOR EXIT**

- 1. THE UK CONTRIBUTES MUCH MORE TO THE BUDGET THAN IT RECEIVES FROM IT**
- 2. UNSUITABLE FOR THE UK EU RULES IN THE FIELDS OF AGRICULTURE, FISHERIES, LAW AND INTERNAL AFFAIRS**

## **REACTION TO VOTING**

- 1. THE SHARP FALL OF MANY INDICES ON THE EXCHANGE**
- 2. THE BRITISH POUND FELL AGAINST THE DOLLAR MUCH MORE THAN EXPECTED**
- 3. THE RESIGNATION OF THE PRIME MINISTER**

- 1. THE DEMAND FOR CITIZENSHIP AND THE RESIDENCE PERMIT OF THE EU MEMBER STATES HAVE INCREASED**
- 2. "BRAIN DRAIN" - FOREIGN SPECIALISTS BECAUSE OF DIFFICULTIES WITH GETTING A VISA MAY PREFER TO IMMIGRATE TO OTHER COUNTRIES**
- 3. CHANGES IN LEGISLATION BASED ON PROVISIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE EU**
- 4. CHANGES IN THE SOCIAL ASSISTANCE PACKAGE FOR IMMIGRANTS**

## **EFFECTS FOR THE EUROPEAN UNION**

- 1. PARTIAL LOSS OF MARKETS IN THE UK IS POSSIBLE**
- 2. PERHAPS THE DEVELOPMENT OF A NEW WAVE OF SEPARATISM AGAINST THE EU IN ALMOST ALL ITS STATES, BUT ESPECIALLY IN GREECE, SWEDEN AND FINLAND**
- 3. THE GROWTH OF THE EURO AGAINST THE POUND**
- 4. PARTIAL OR COMPLETE EXPULSION FROM ENGLAND OF LABOR MIGRANTS**
- 5. CREATION OF A CHECKPOINT AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE TUNNEL UNDER THE CHANNEL, WHICH WILL GREATLY INCREASE THE TRAVEL TIME OF THE PARIS-LONDON TRAIN**
