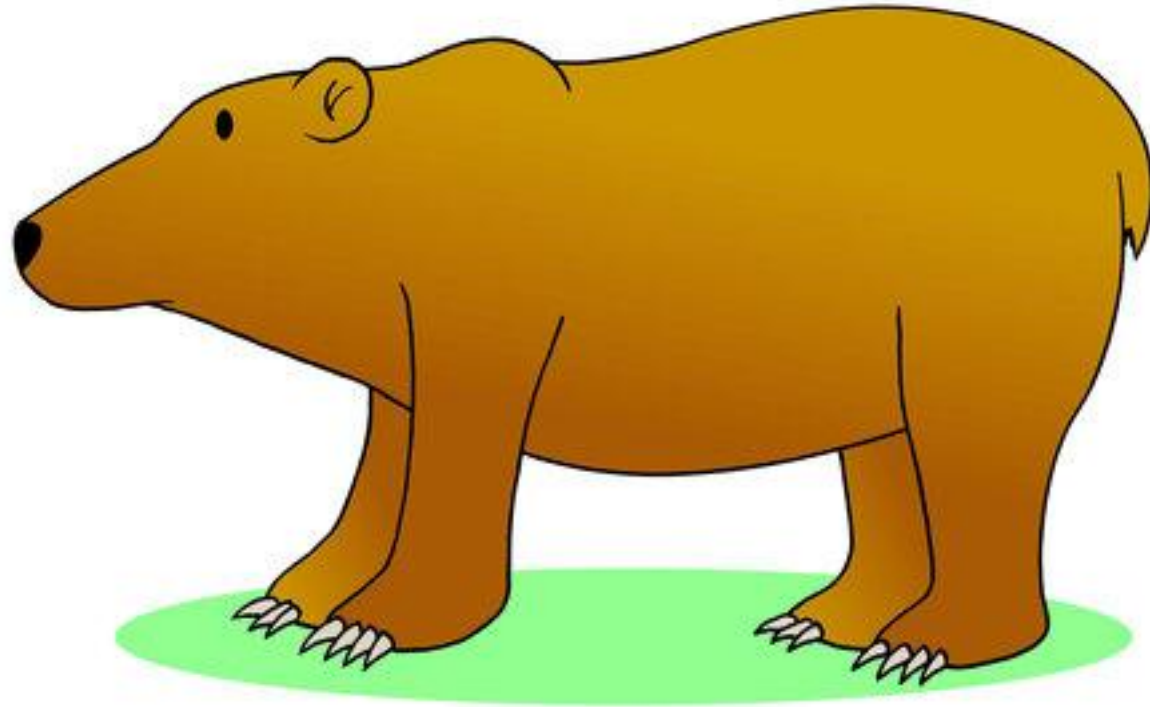


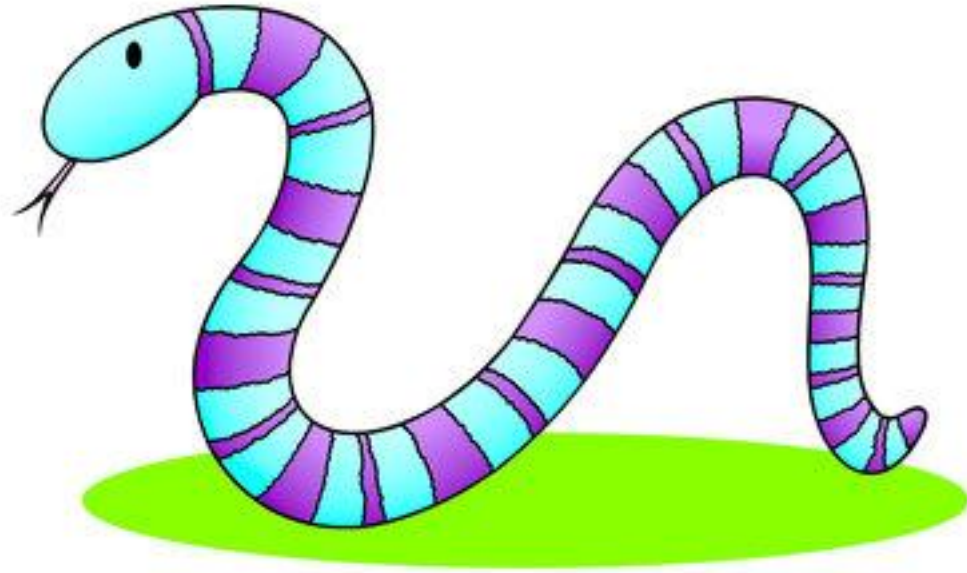
Red lorry, yellow lorry



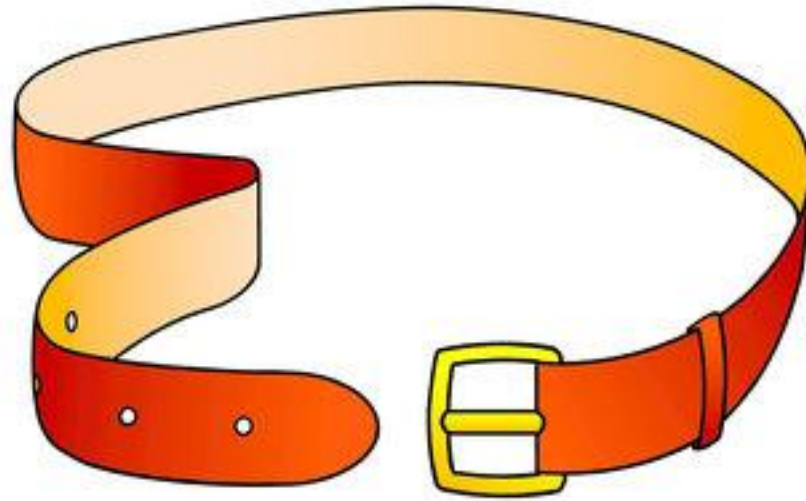

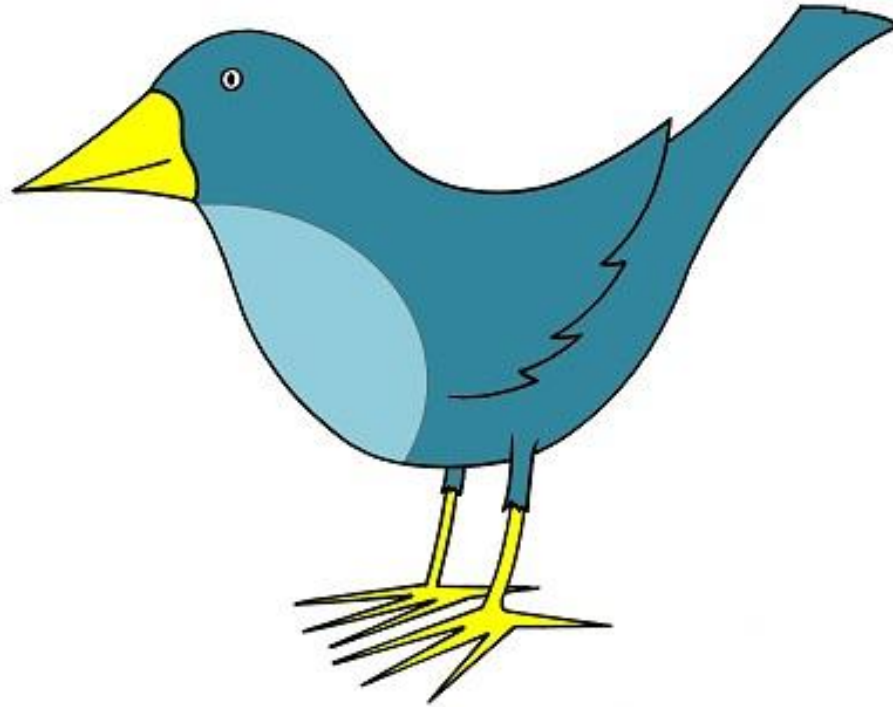

with sixty super scaly stripes.



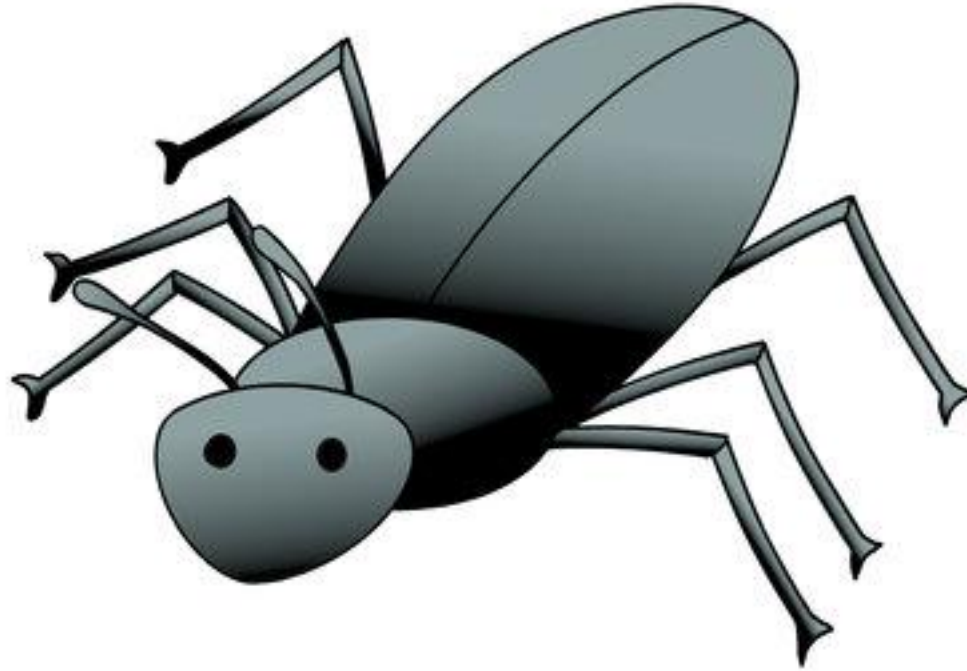
Red leather,
yellow leather.



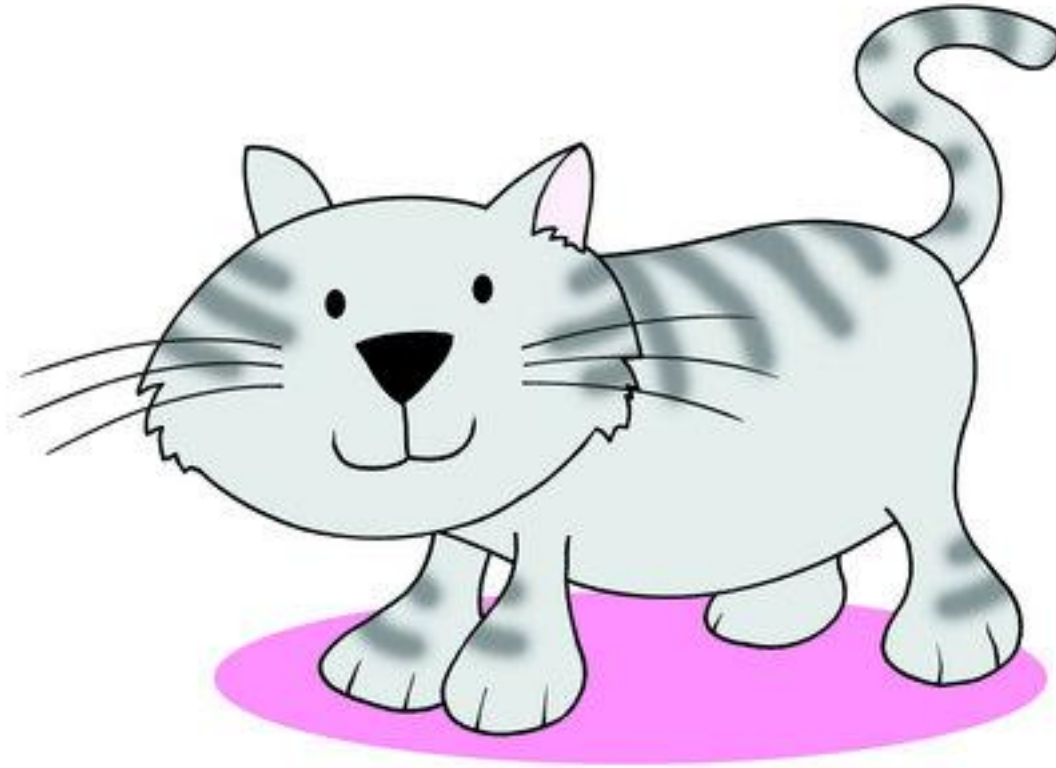
The blue bluebird blinks.

in the kitchen.



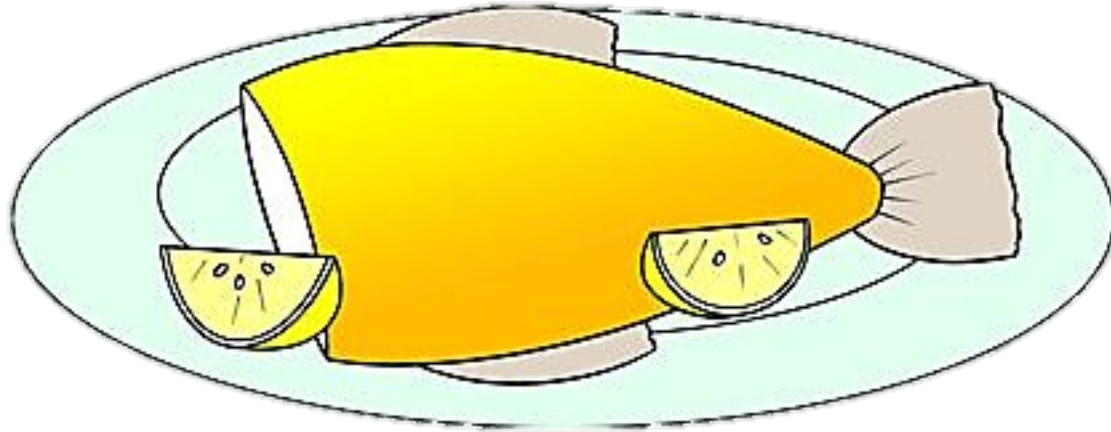
If you want to buy, buy,

bye-bye!



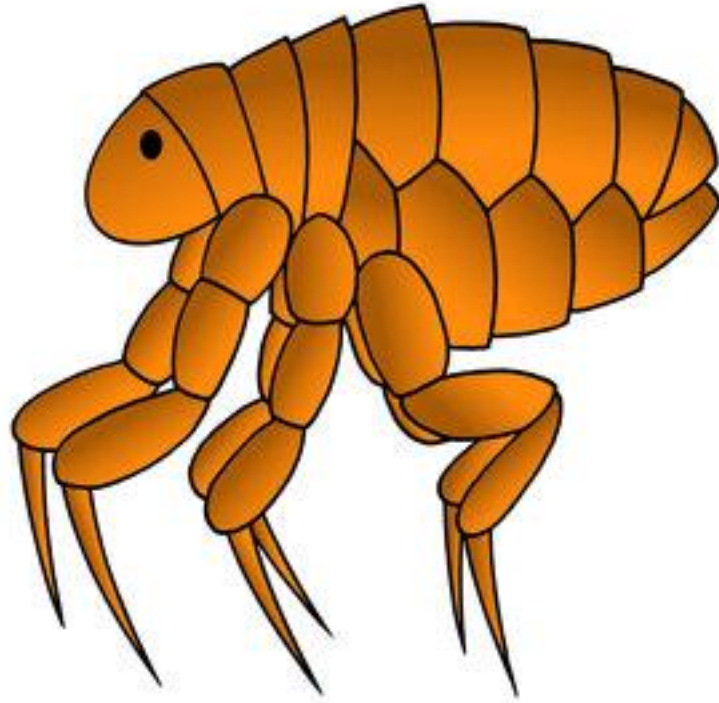
Give papa a cup of proper coffee
in a copper coffee cup.



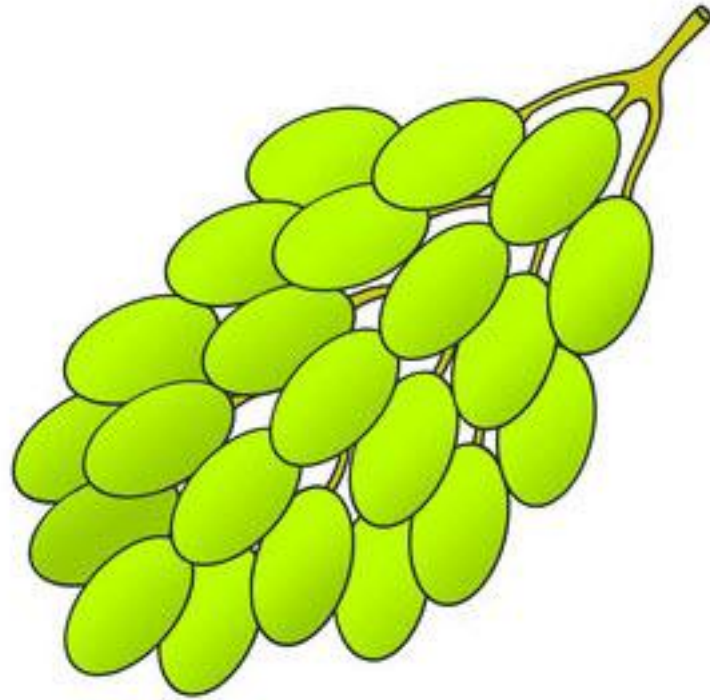
Eleven elves licked

fresh.



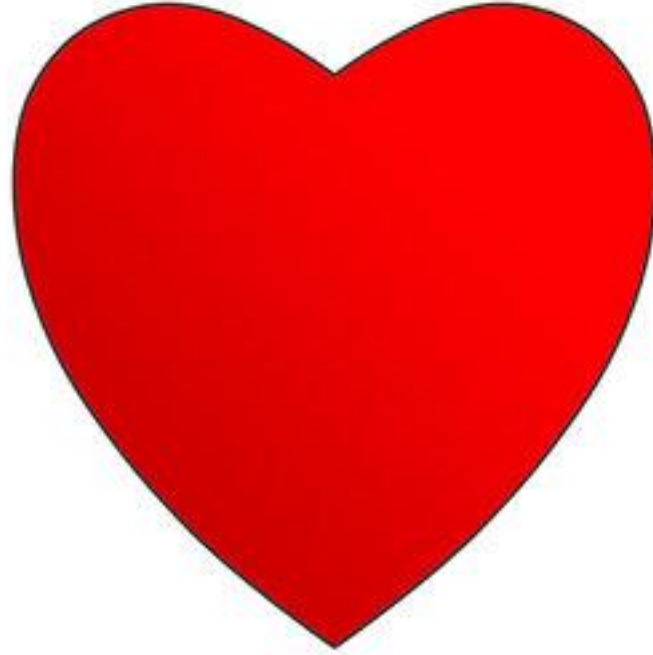
Friendly fleas and fireflies.



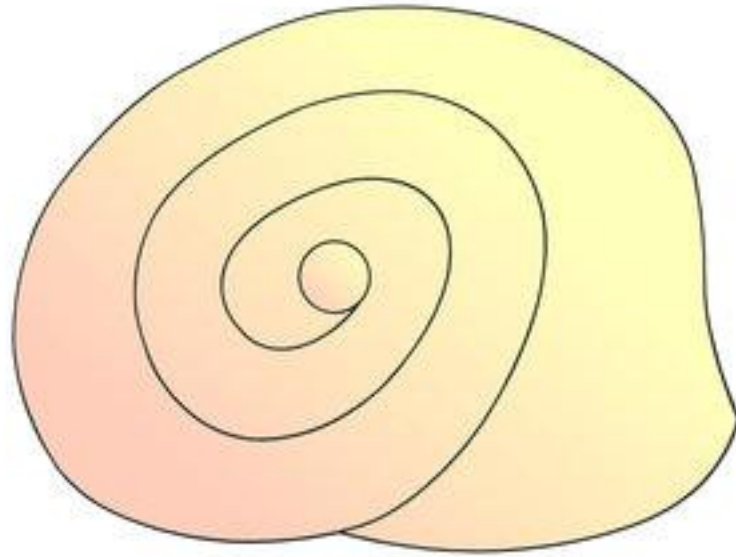

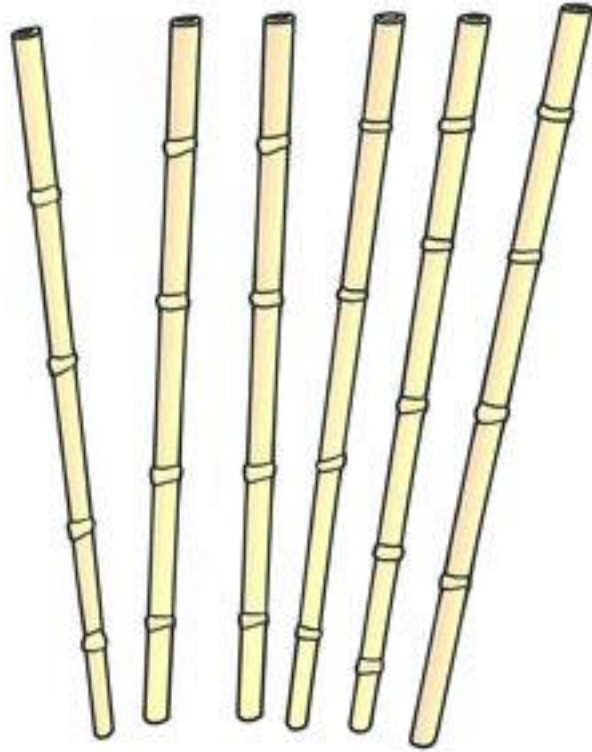
I scream, you scream,
we all scream for ice cream.



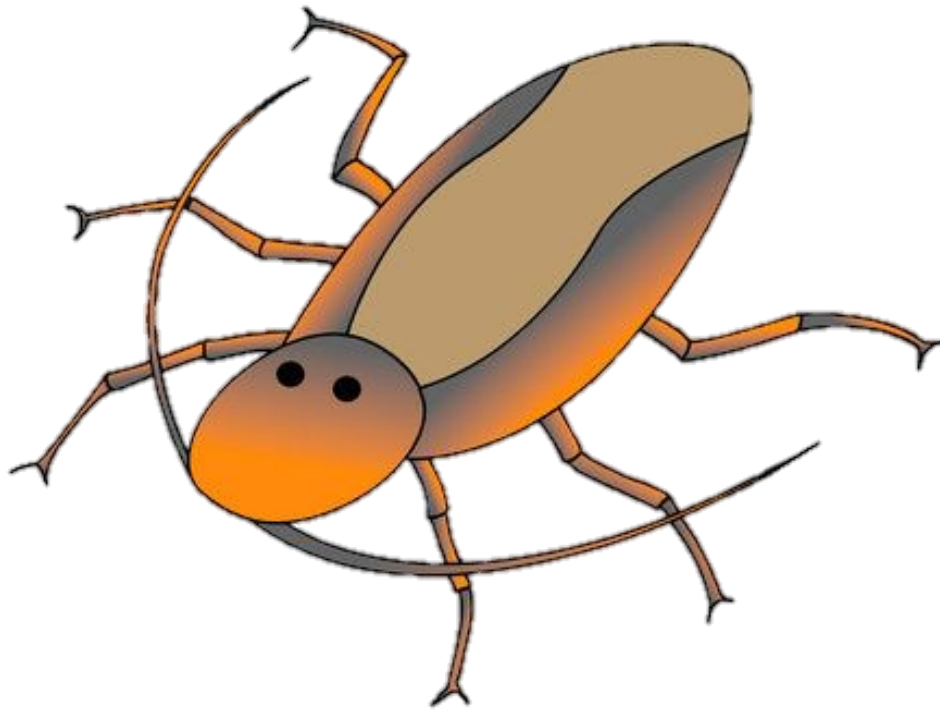
Quick kiss, quick kiss,
quick kiss.



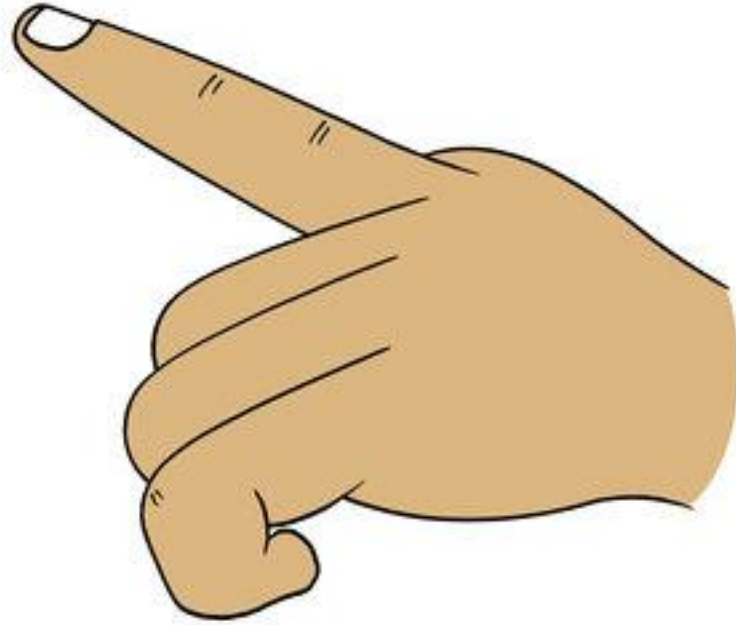
She sells seashells

of six thick things too.



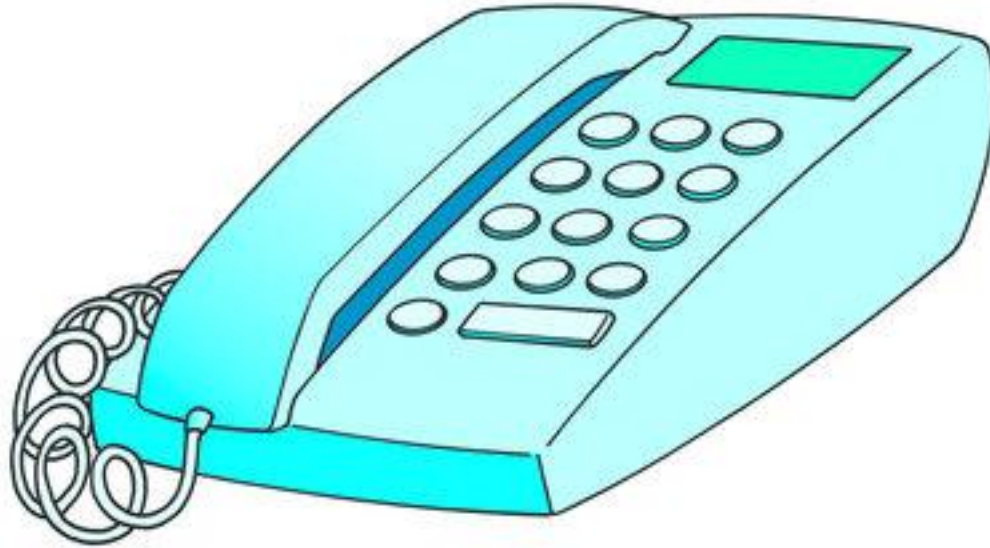
The big bug

but those things there.



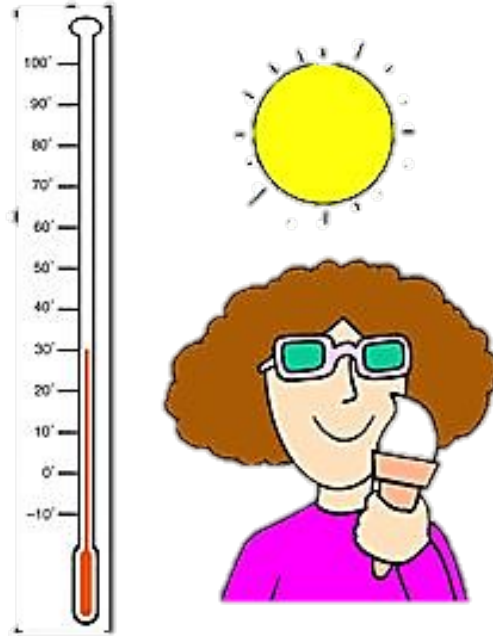
Three free throws.
