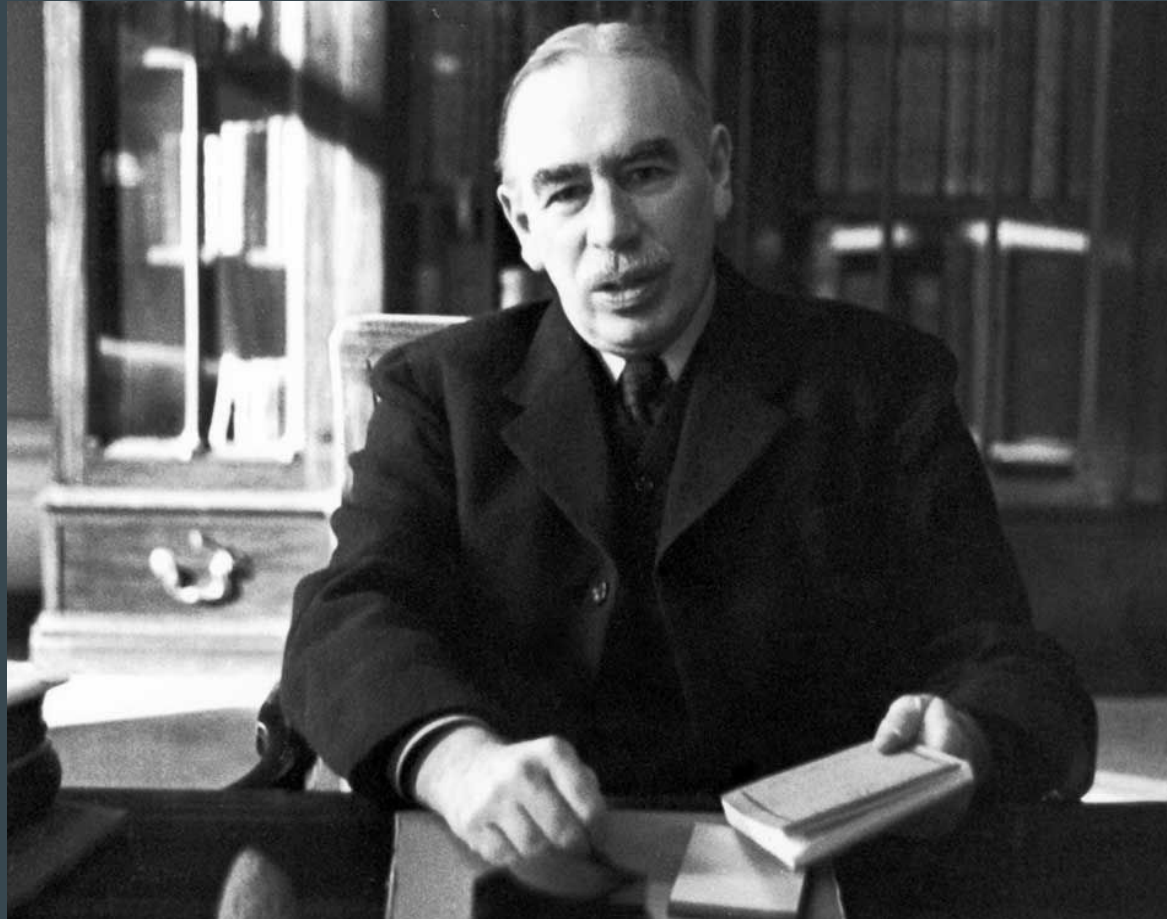


John Maynard Keynes

Keynes was born in 1883
in Cambridge (England)
-English economist, founder
of the Keynesian trend in
economics



- In 1920, Keynes dealt with global problems of economics and finance.
- In 1923, the scientist published a Treatise on Monetary Reform.
- In 1930, A Treatise on Money, where Keynes explored exchange rates and the gold standard.
- In 1936, Keynes published his main work, The General Theory of Employment, Interest and Money, which made the scientist the leader of economic science and economic policy of that time.
- In 1999 , Time magazine included Keynes among the most important people of the century.
