Comparatives: Short adjectives

| Short adjectives | Spelling rules | Examples |
|---|------------------------------|---|
| Usually | + er | slow → slower fast → faster tall → taller |
| Ending in -e | + r | large → larger nice → nicer |
| Some two-syllable adjectives, especially ending in -y | -y → -i + er | hungry → hungrier happy → happier funny → funnier |
| Ending in a vowel + a consonant | double the consonant + er | big → bigger fat → fatter fit → fitter |

bad - worse - the worst far - further -the furthest far - farther - the farthest good - better - the best many - more - the most little - less - the least old - elder / older - the eldest/oldest
