- There aren't + plural (any)

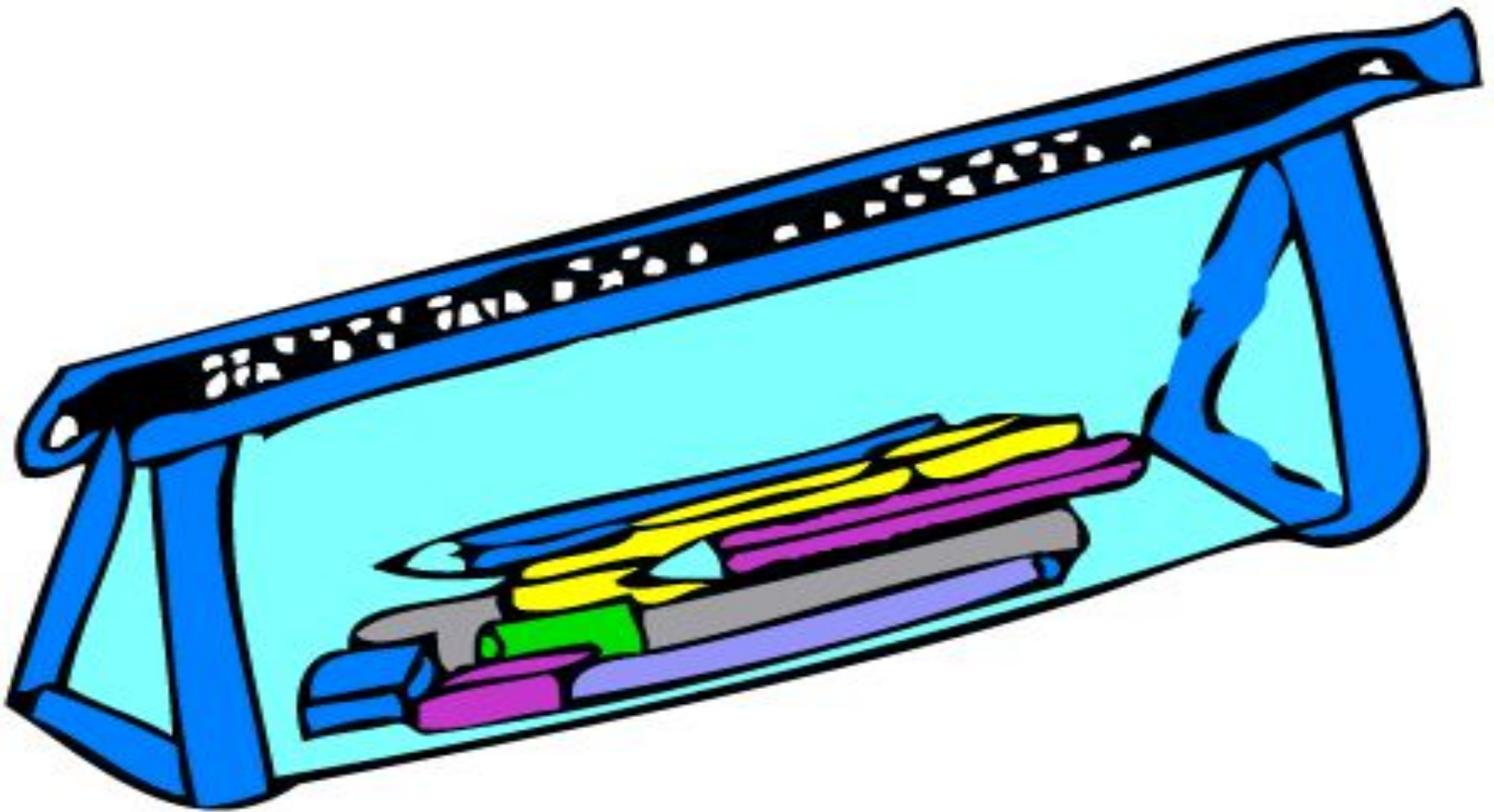

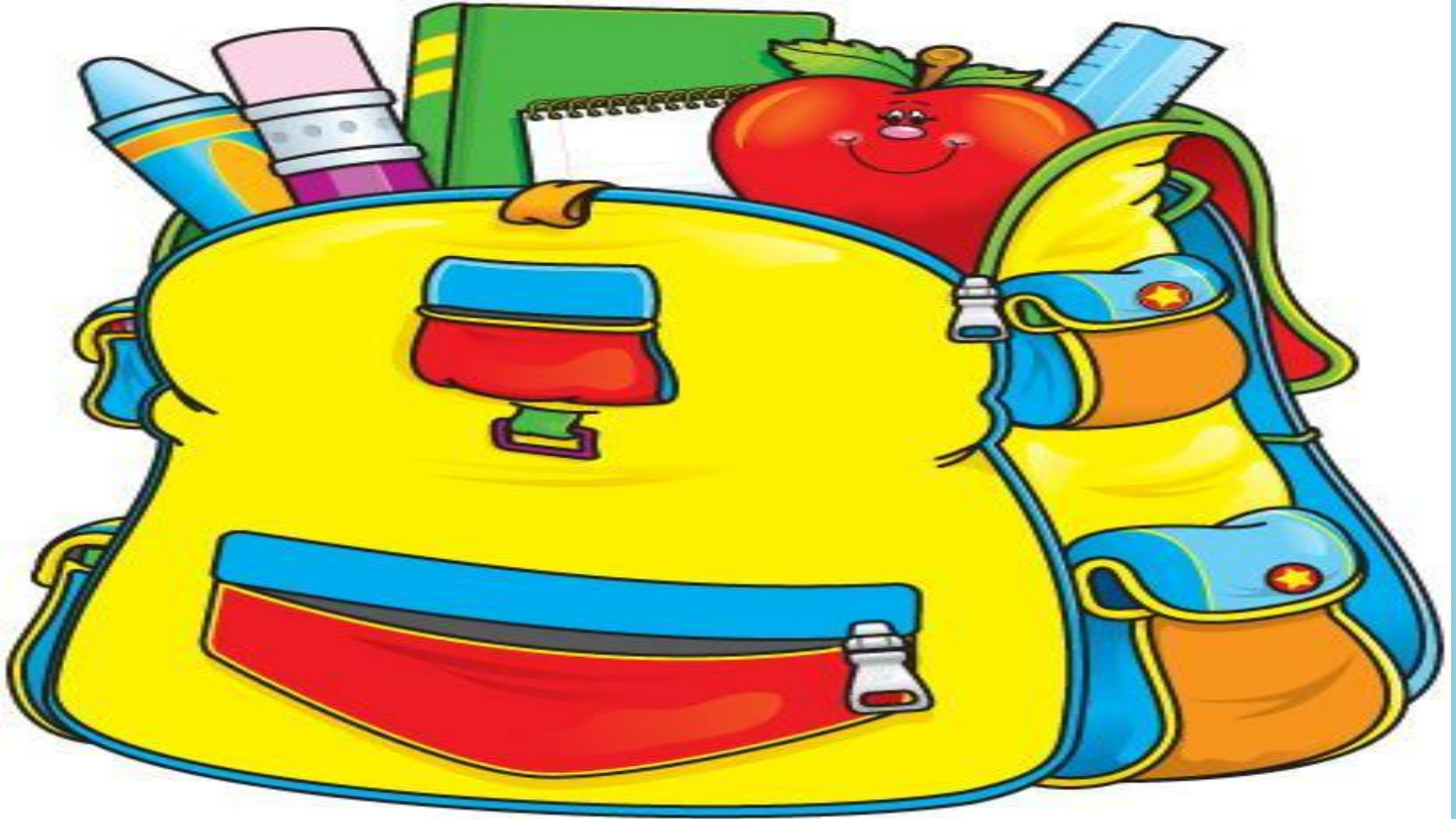
