



**1 SPECIALIZED EDUCATION** [uncountable and countable] a school for advanced education, especially in a particular profession or skill

→ **collegiate**:

- *a teacher training college*
- *the London College of Fashion*
- *Donna left school and **went to** art **college**.*

**at college**

- *We were great friends when we were at college.*

**2 US UNIVERSITY** [uncountable and countable] *American English* a large school where you can study after HIGH SCHOOL and get a degree SYNONYM **university** *British English*

- *Some people who want to **go to college** still can't get there.*

**in college**

- *Fran just finished her freshman year in college.*

**3 PART OF A UNIVERSITY** [countable] one of the groups of teachers and students that form a separate part of some universities, especially in Britain → **collegiate**:

#### **4 College**

**College** is used in Britain in the names of some secondary schools which charge fees.

*In 1854, Cheltenham Ladies' College became the first girls' public school.*

**5 PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATION** [countable] a group of people who have special rights, duties, or powers within a profession or organization:

- *the American College of Surgeons*

#### **6 College**

At some universities in the United States, **colleges** are divisions which offer degrees in particular subjects.

*...a professor at the University of Florida College of Law.*
