is the activity of trying to predict what is going to happen, on the basis of facts about what is happening now.

SCIENCE FICTION = SCI-FI = SF

- is a genre of speculative fiction
- typically deals with imaginative and futuristic concepts :
- is advanced science & technology
- is space exploration, time travel, parallel universes
- Is the "literature of ideas"
