FORM HAIRCUTS





CASCADE (PROGRESSIVE) - THE HAIR OF THE PARIETAL ZONE IS SHORTER THAN ON THE TEMPORAL AND OCCIPITAL ZONES

GRADED - IN THIS FORM, THE HAIR ON THE LOWER OCCIPITAL ZONE IS SHORTER, AND ON THE PARIETAL AND UPPER OCCIPITAL ZONES IS LONGER





MONOLITHIC (MASSIVE) - FOR EXAMPLE,
A CLASSIC CARET. ALL HAIR TRIMMED
IN ANY ONE LINE

UNIFORM - THE LENGTH OF THE HAIR ALL OVER THE HEAD IS THE SAME, REPEATS THE **SHAPE OF THE HEAD**
