

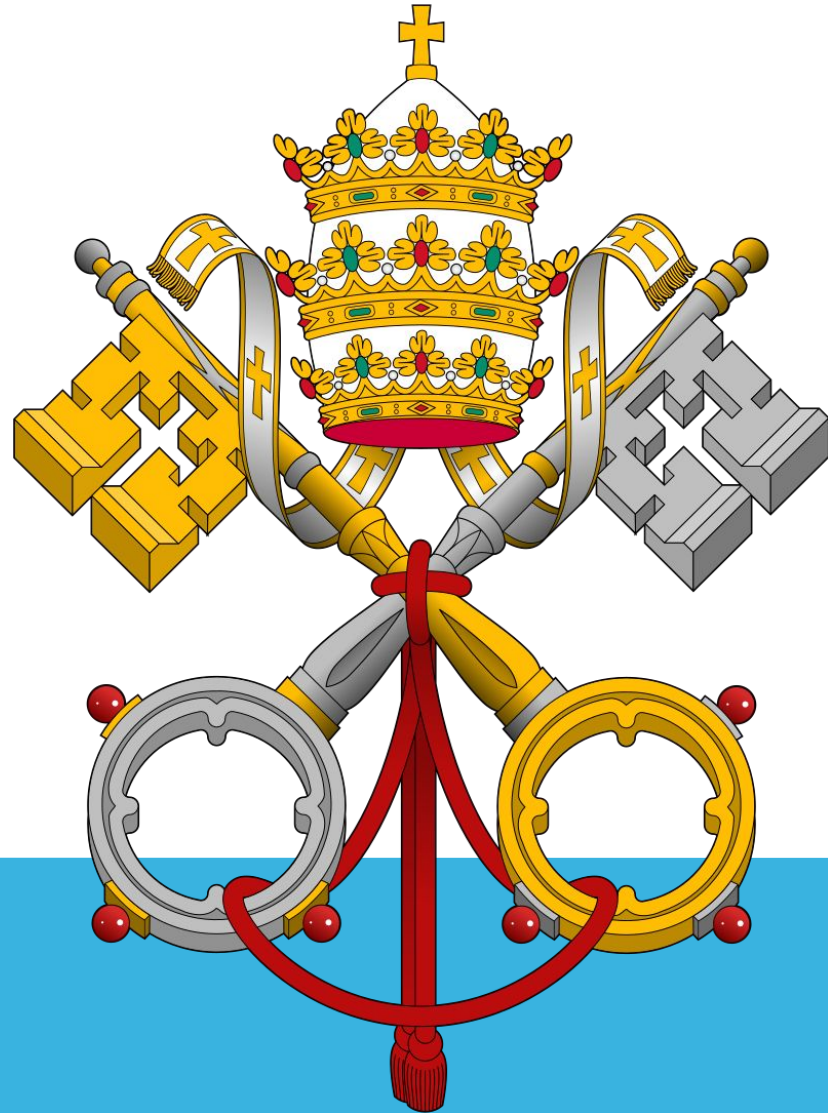

# CATHOLIC CHURCH

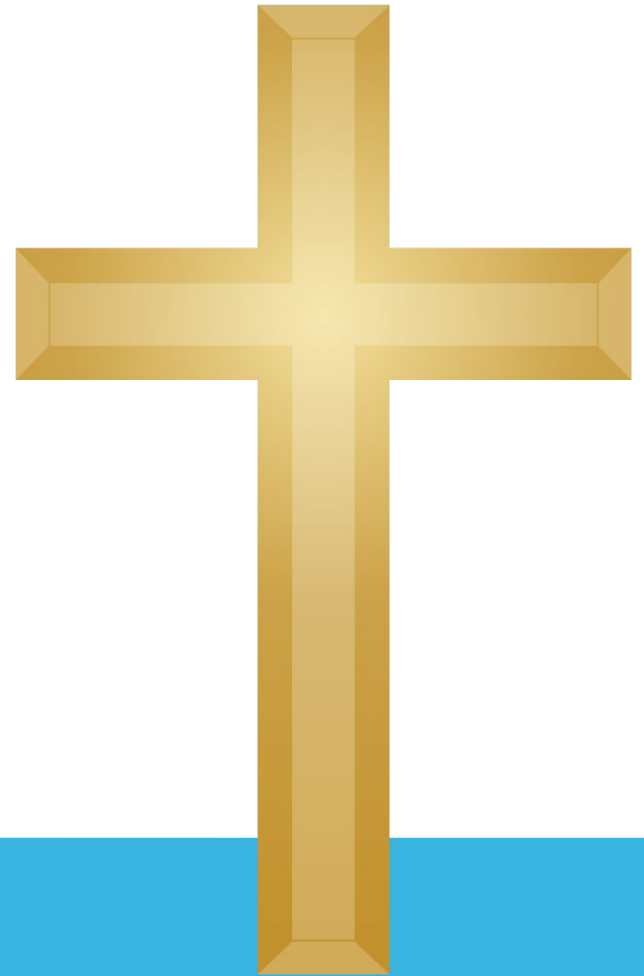
In 2011, in total there were roughly 5.7 million Catholics (9.1%) in the United Kingdom:

- 4,155,100 in England and Wales (7.4%)
- 841,053 in Scotland (15.9%)
- 738,033 in Northern Ireland (40.76%).

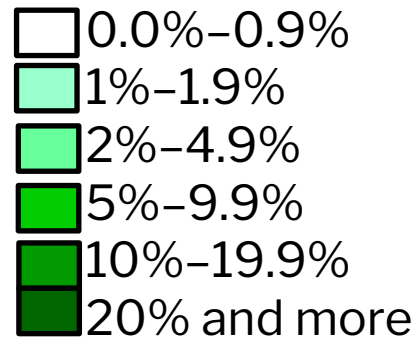
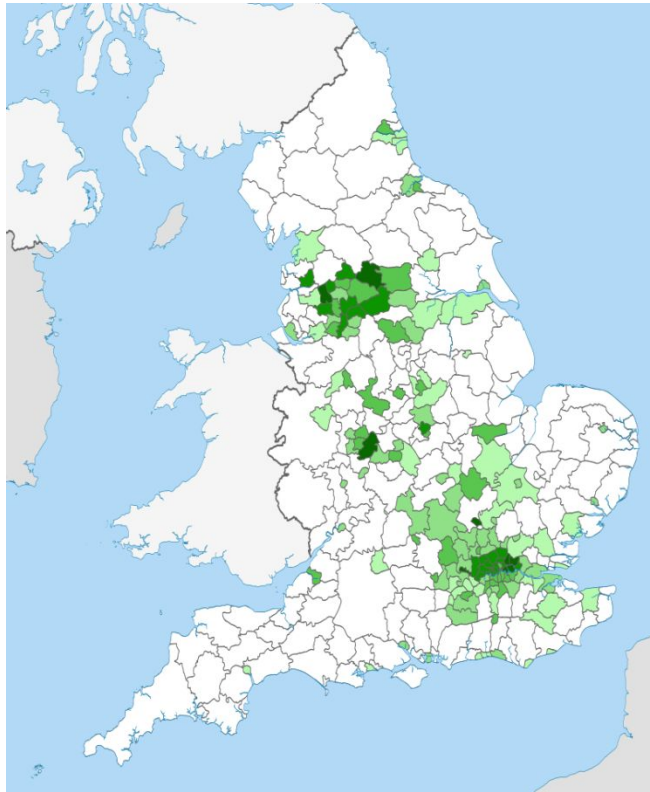


# PROTESTANTISM
