She **plays** with a ball.

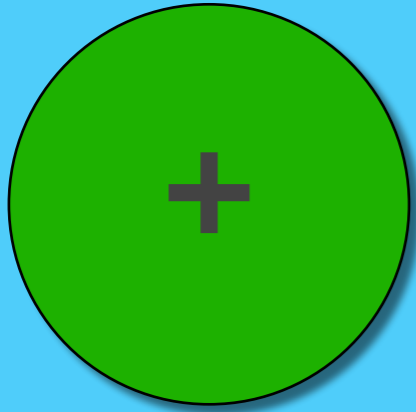
It **plays** with a ball.

he/she/it does

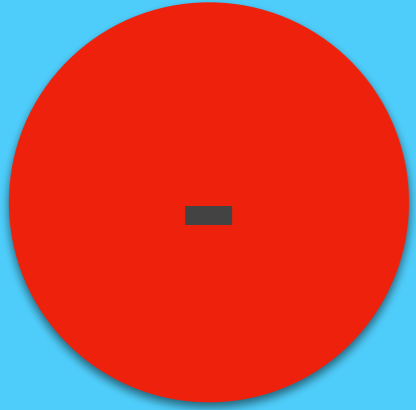
we do

# Negative (do)

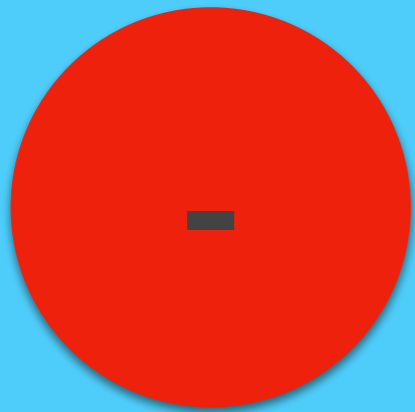
I do not do that

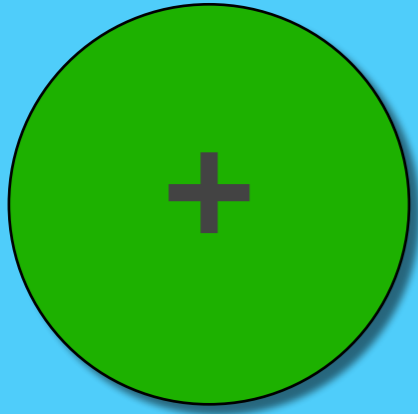

friends

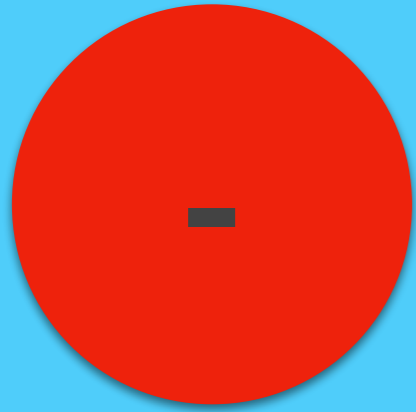

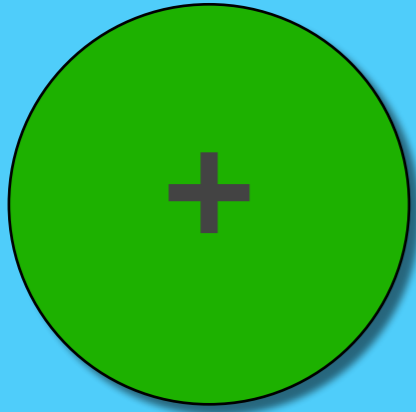

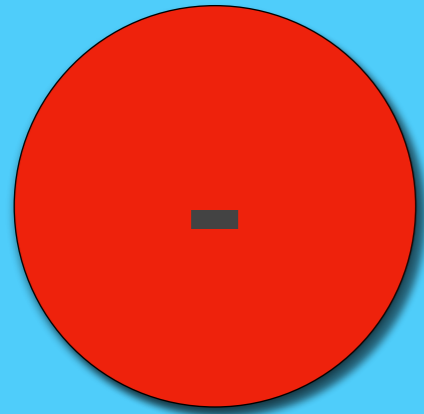
