


Study the dictionary definition. What is the Russian for 'disabled people'?

• Blind person/people (only when a person cannot see anything), visually impaired (not 'the blind').

 Deaf person/people (only when a person cannot hear anything), hard of hearing (not 'the deaf').



disability / disə'biliti/ n a physical or mental condition that makes it difficult for someone to do things that most people do easily, such as walk or see.


disabled /dis'eibəld/ adj someone is disabled cannot use a part of their body in the way most people are able to. There's a lift for disabled people.
