- Says: "China is a socialist state of the people's democratic dictatorship led by the working class and based on the alliance of workers and peasants; The socialist system is the basic system of China. It is forbidden by any organizations or individuals to undermine the socialist system "




Peoples Republic of China is divided into:

- 22 provinces (+ Taiwan), 5 autonomous regions, 4 cities of the central submission and 2 special autonomous regions (Hong Kong and Macau)? - The province, autonomous regions are divided into autonomous prefectures, counties, autonomous counties and cities? -Counties, autonomous counties are divided in the townships, ethnic townships and towns.

The fundamental rights of Chinese citizens:? - The right to elect and be elected? - Freedom of speech, press, assembly, association? -Freedom of religion? - The right to make criticism or suggestions to address any public authorities? - The right to work and the duty to work? - the right to rest? - the right to education and the duty to learn? - women have equal rights



The main duties of Chinese citizens:? - Does not harm the interests of the state, society, the collective, the legitimate freedoms and rights of other citizens? - To protect the unity of the state and the unity of all ethnic groups of the country? - To protect the security, honor and interests of the country? - In accordance with the law to pay taxes



Legislative power belongs to the National People's Congress (NPC)? Between sessions of the functions of the NPC Standing Committee serves



The executive power belongs to the State Council of China (Central People's Government)? The head of the State Council, Prime Minister, now - Wen


