

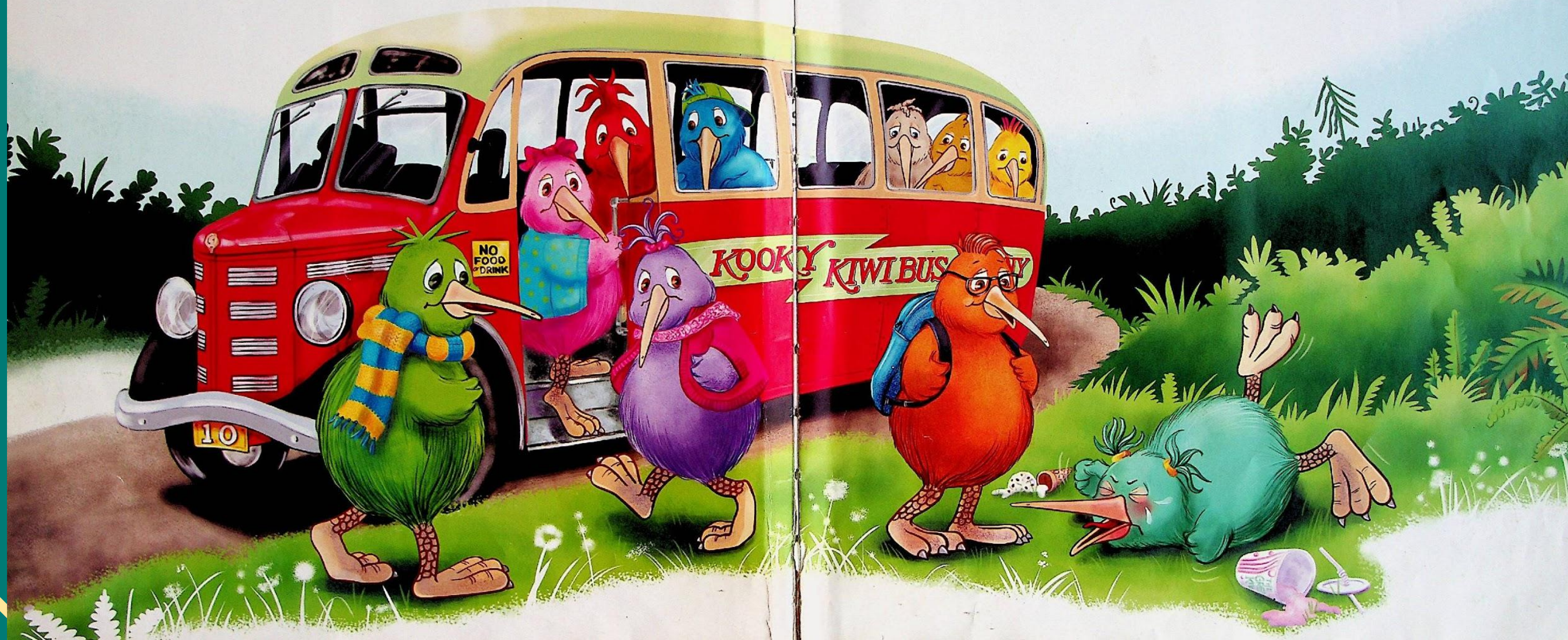

**one** kooky kiwi, walking all alone,

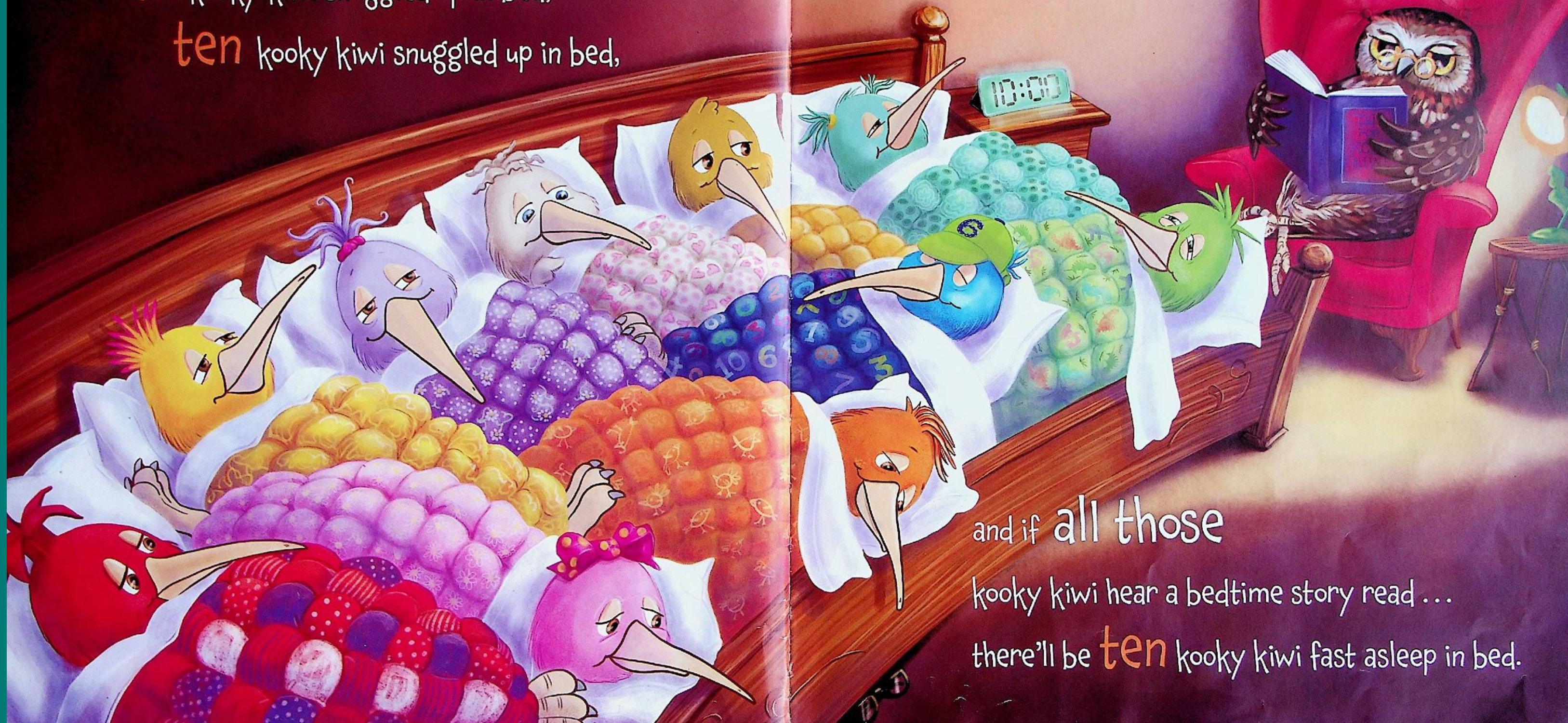


and if **that** kooky kiwi walks all the way back home ...

ka whā kiwi rerekē ka tākoro pāoro.



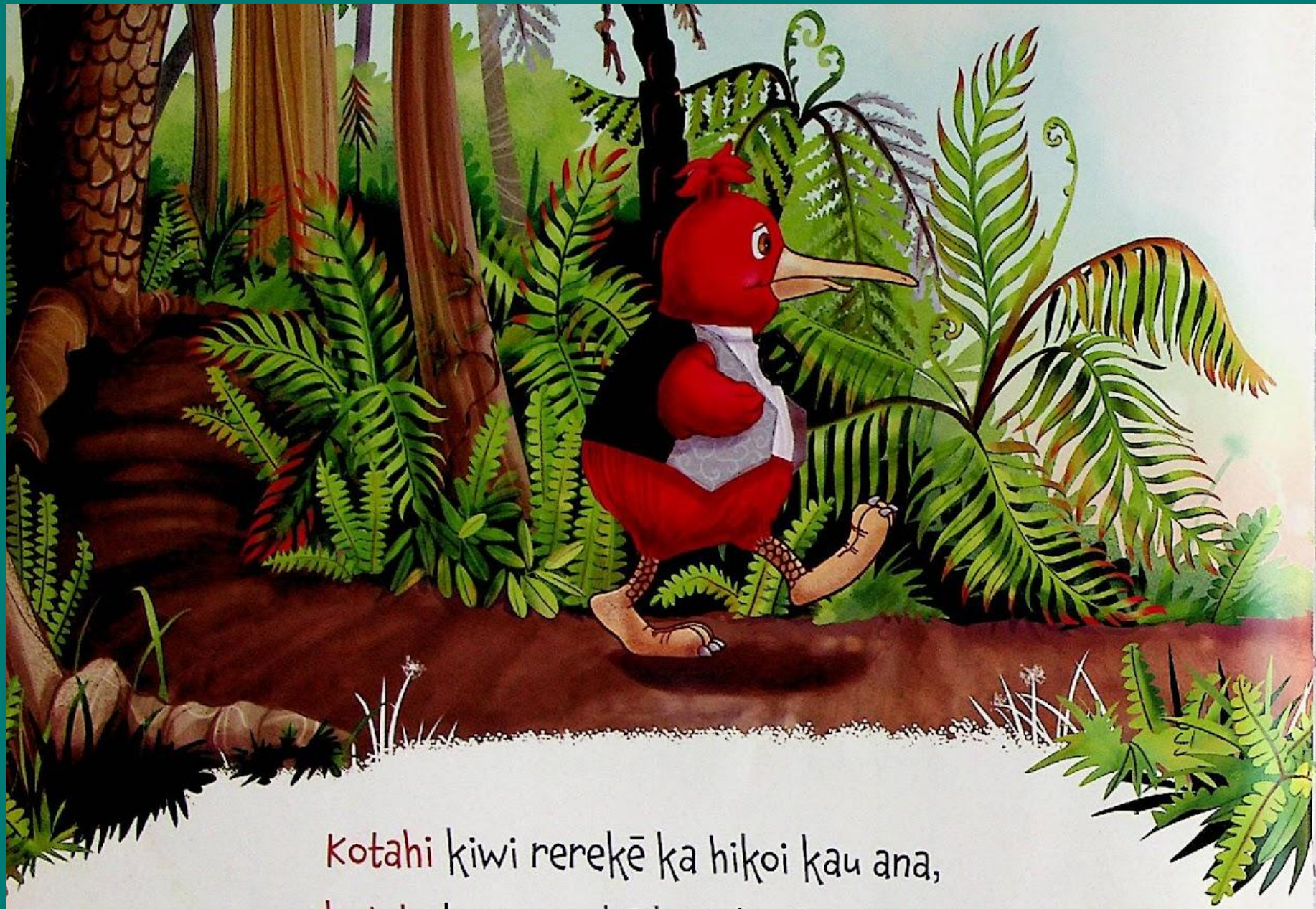
