The other is given over to a special luxury apartment with a fantastic underwater landscape outside the window. of course, this hotel has 18 floors. 16 of them are located below ground level and only two rise above the surface.

Even the roof managed to be used, there is a huge park area on it, which occupies 3 thousand square meters, serving as an original decoration and a great place to relax, as well as additional protection of the room itself from the effects of weather conditions. The total area of the complex is 428,200 square meters. meters.

This is how the House Arrest Hotel in Roermond appeared. This is a former prison from 1863, the cells of which were turned into luxury suites. Here you can even rent an entire compartment to host a party for up to 200 people. The hotel offers The Jailer, The Lawyer, The Director, and The Judge suites. Of course, the hotel has access to Wi-Fi, TVs, a gourmet restaurant, a fitness center and a sauna. The price for a room starts from € 112 per night.
