




There is a legend about how the Bishop of Pur, who led the move to the plain in 1219, chose the site for the future temple. Allegedly, he ordered to shoot an arrow from the heights of Old Sarum and notice the place where it fell. It was here that Salisbury Cathedral was built - one of the main attractions of the city.

Less than twenty kilometers from Salisbury is Stonehenge. This most famous prehistoric monument needs no introduction. The circle of massive stones, each up to four meters high, was created about 5,000 years ago. Scientists have found that the largest blue stones of the outer ring were mined in the Prezeli hills, and then somehow transported to this island. Stonehenge is shrouded in many mysteries and is the most mysterious and famous monument in the UK.
