Grandpa points up. ‘There!’ he says. ‘I can see some durians in that tree!’

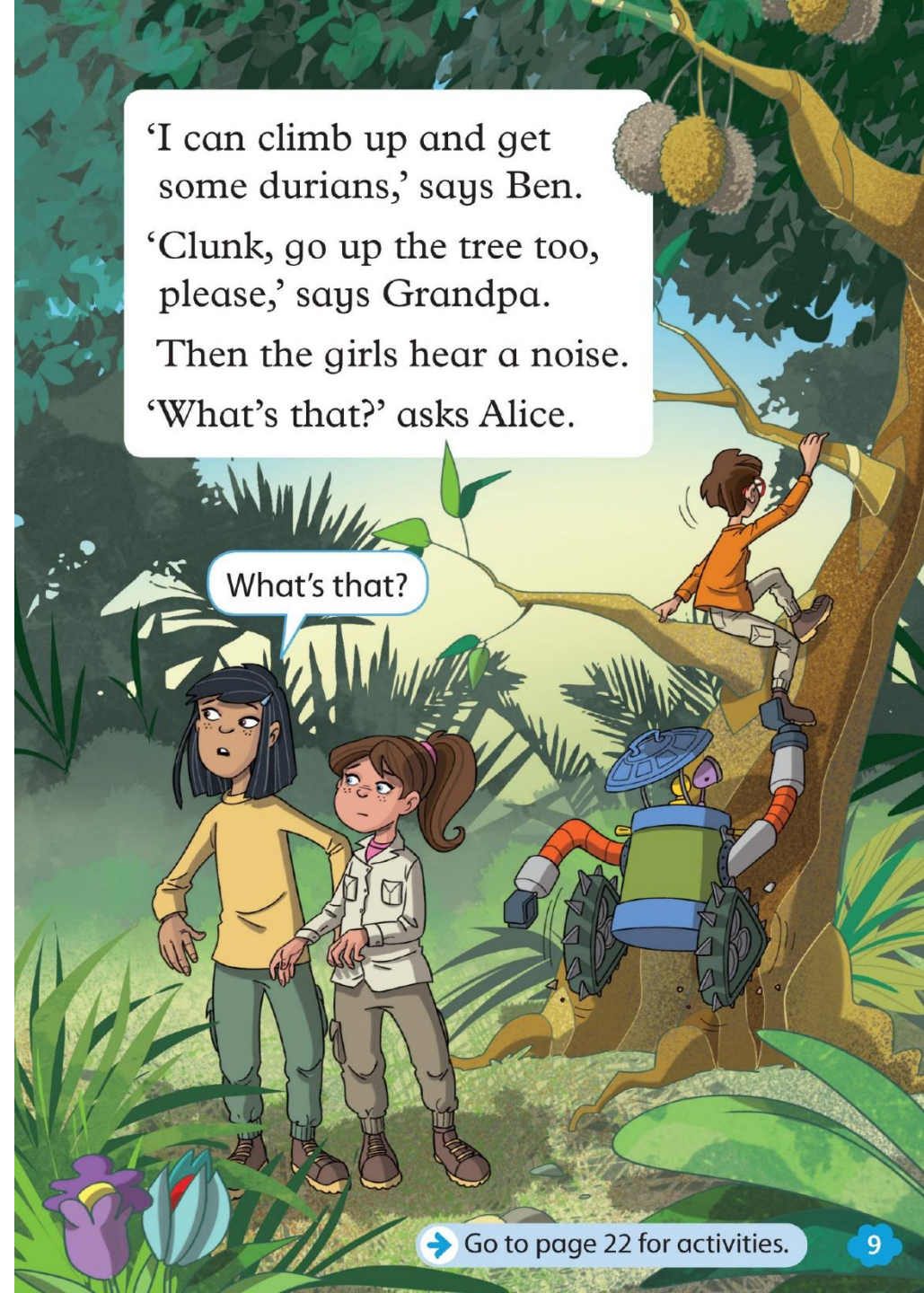


‘I can climb up and get some durians,’ says Ben.

'Baby orangutans live with their mothers for years,' says Grandpa.

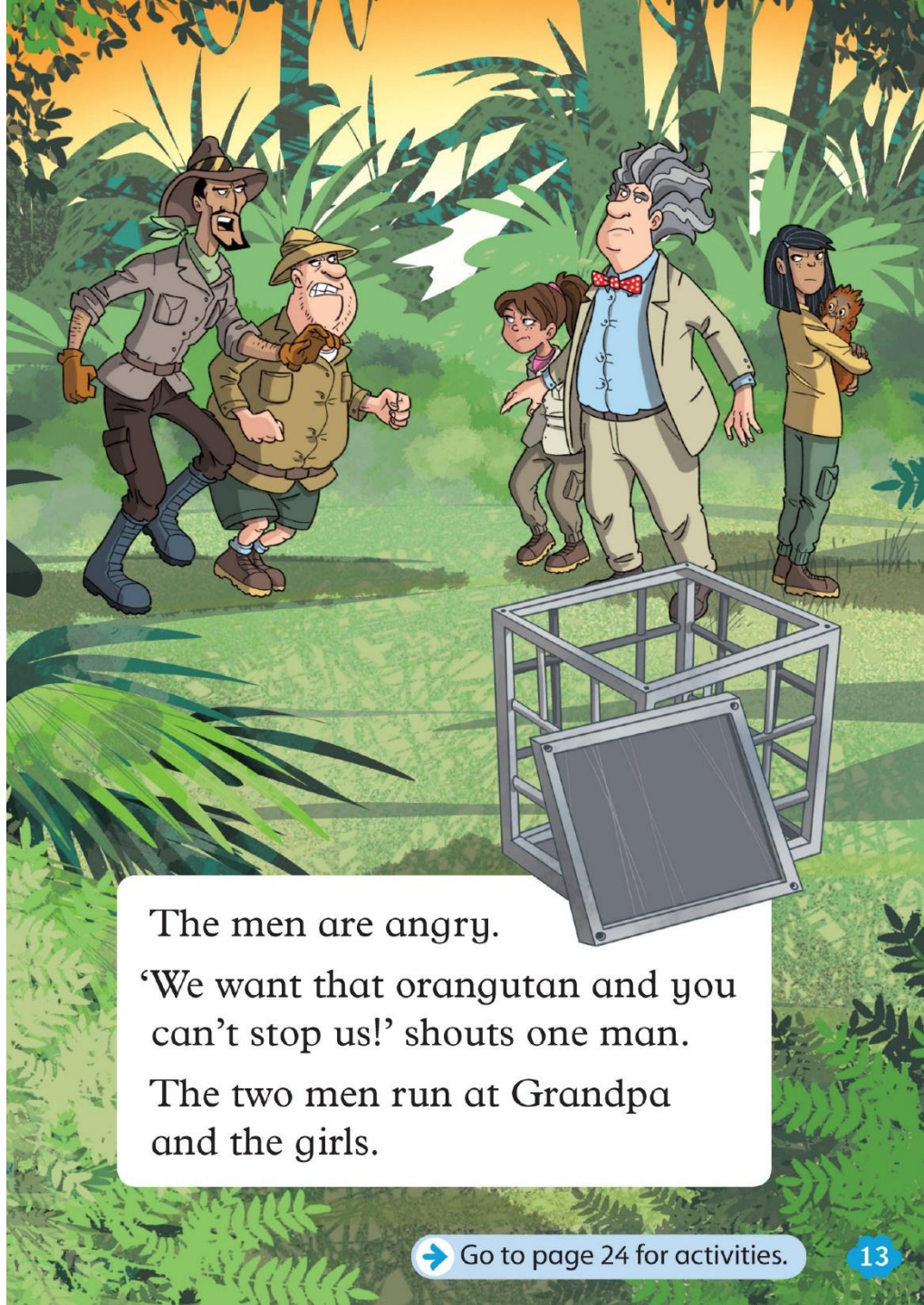

The men are angry.

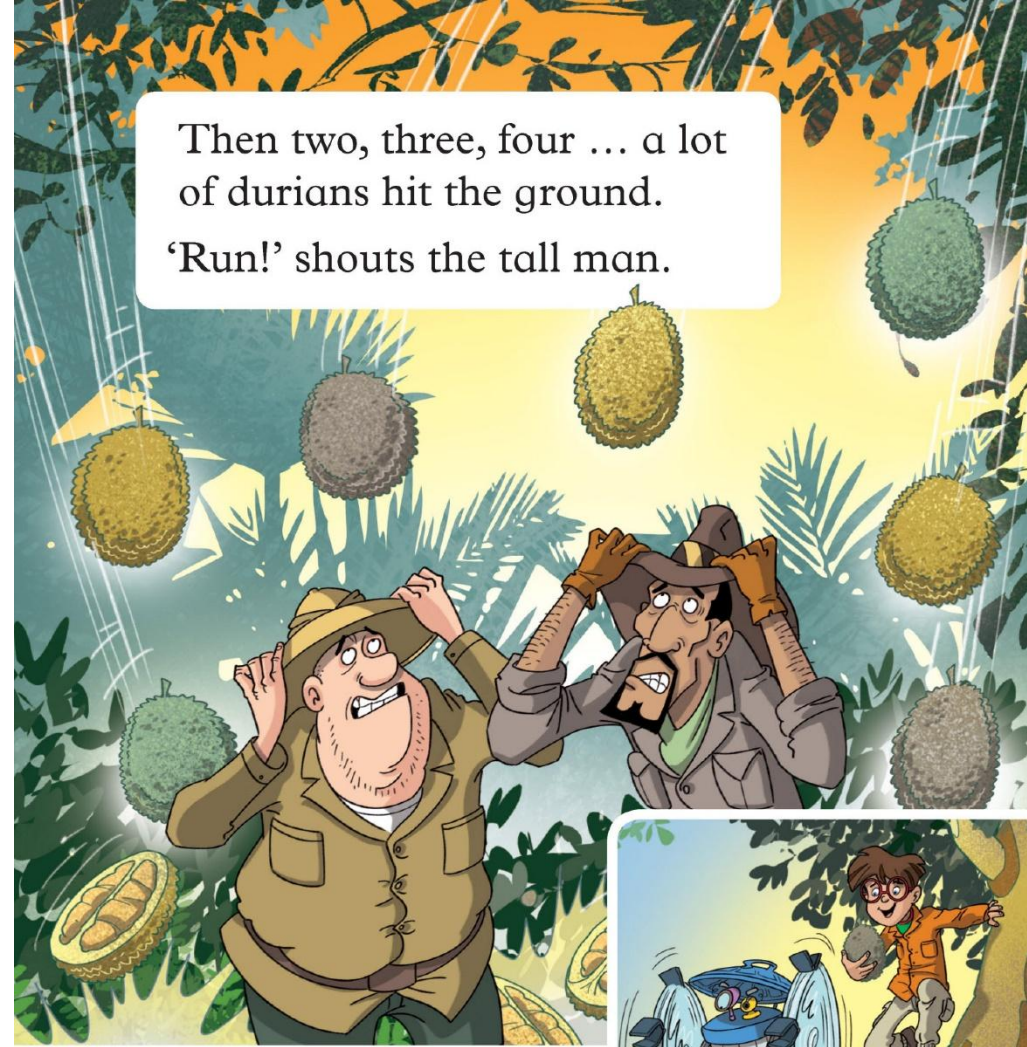
‘We want that orangutan and you can’t stop us!’ shouts one man.
