Type 2.
(unreal present)

USE: improbable situation in
the present or future; also
used to give advice.

(If Past Simple), [would/could/might + inf].

(If I **were** you), [I **would see** a doctor]. (advice)

(If I **had** money), [I **could buy** a new car].

(But I don't have enough
money to buy one,
improbable situation)
