Harassment

/'hærəsmənt/

- Преследование, притеснение

Most harassment complaints received relate to employment.

BLAME
/bleɪm/

- ВИНИТЬ

They apologized for the delay and blamed it on technical problems.

CHIEF

/tʃiːf/

- **ОСНОВНОЙ, ВАЖНЕЙШИЙ**

The wonderful weather was our chief reason for coming here.

- **старший, главный**

chief economic adviser to the government

chief priests - первосвященники

Weapon

/'wepən/

- оружие

They were carrying torches, lanterns and weapons.

Sword

/sɔːd/

- меч, шпага

Apparently his sword was as mighty as his pen.

Tempt

/tempt/

- **уговаривать, склонять**
- [+ to do sth] She's trying to tempt me to go shopping with her.
- To be *tempted to*
- *поддаться искушению*

Solve

/sɒlv/

- решать, раскрывать

to solve a problem

to solve a mystery/puzzle

Police are still no nearer to solving the crime.

Adult

/'ædʌlt, ə'dʌlt/

- **взрослый**

Please note: each adult passenger can travel with only one infant.

Regret

/rɪ'gret/

- сожалеть, раскаиваться

[+ doing sth] I really regret leaving school so young.

[+ (that)] He began to regret that he hadn't paid more attention in class.

- сожалеть

[+ to do sth] We regret to inform you that the application has been refused.

Torch

/tɔ:tʃ/

- карманный фонарь
- факел

Traitor

/'treɪtər/

- предатель

And Judas the traitor was standing there with them.

COWARDLY

/'kʌʊədli/

- трусливо

Such acts are blind, cowardly and repugnant.

STRIKE

/straɪk/

- ударять, стукнуть

*His car went out of control and struck a tree.
I've never heard of anyone being struck by lightning.*

- нападать, атаковать

The marines will strike at dawn.
Strike, Struck, Struck/Stricken

ENEMY

/ˈenəmi/

- враг

*I try not to **make** any **enemies**.*

- противник

enemy forces/territory

AUTHORITY

/ɔːˈθɒrəti/

- **ВЛАСТЬ**

a position of authority

[+ to do sth] *The investigators have the authority to examine all the company's records.*

We need the support of someone in authority.

- **АВТОРИТЕТ**

She has an air of authority.

DETACHMENT

/dɪ'tætʃmənt/

- отряд, группа (в армии)

a detachment of soldiers and some officials

- беспристрастность

He spoke with cool detachment.

LANTERN

/'læntən/

- фонарь

a paper lantern

FULFILLED

/fʊl'fɪld/

- удовлетворенный
- исполненный

This happened so that the words he had spoken would be fulfilled.

REVERENCE

/ˈrevərəns/

- почитание
- благоговение

Out of reverence

VIOLENTLY

/'vaɪələntli/

- жестоко, яростно

What enemy have you been tempted to strike violently against.

ИМПАКТ

/ˈɪmpækt/

- **ВЛИЯНИЕ, ВОЗДЕЙСТВИЕ**

Latino singers have had a major impact on pop music this year.

- **удар, столкновение**

The missile explodes on impact (= when it hits another object).

- **ВЛИЯТЬ**

Rising interest rates are sure to impact on the housing market.
