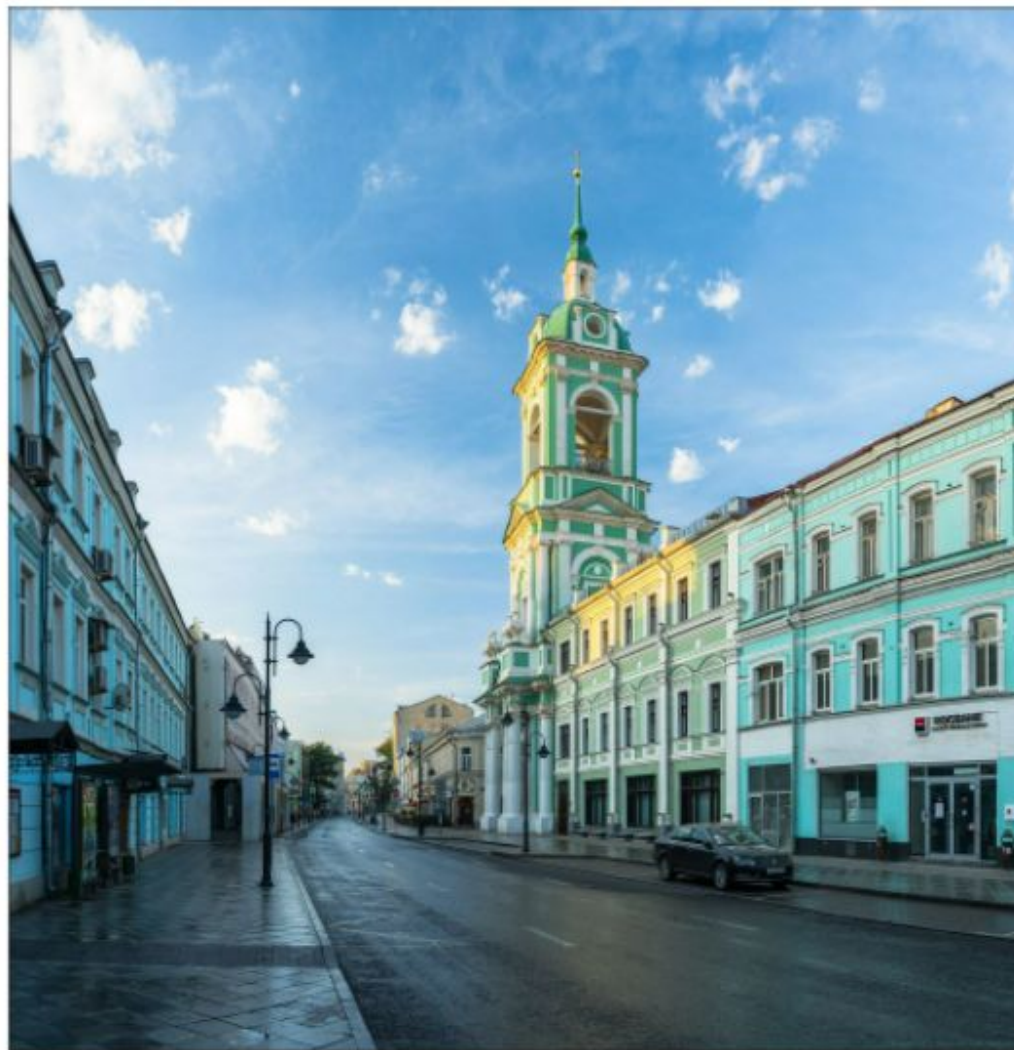

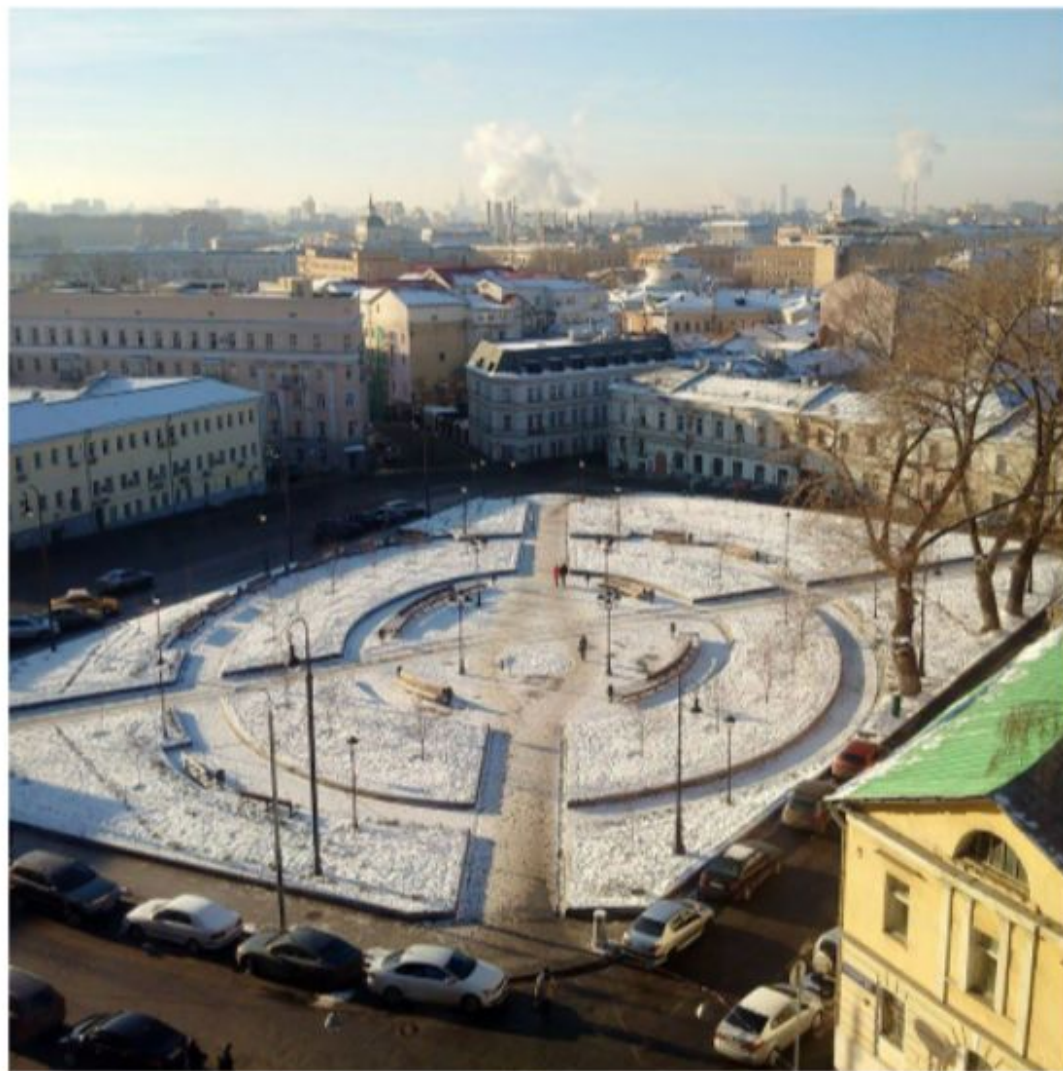


Petrovka Street

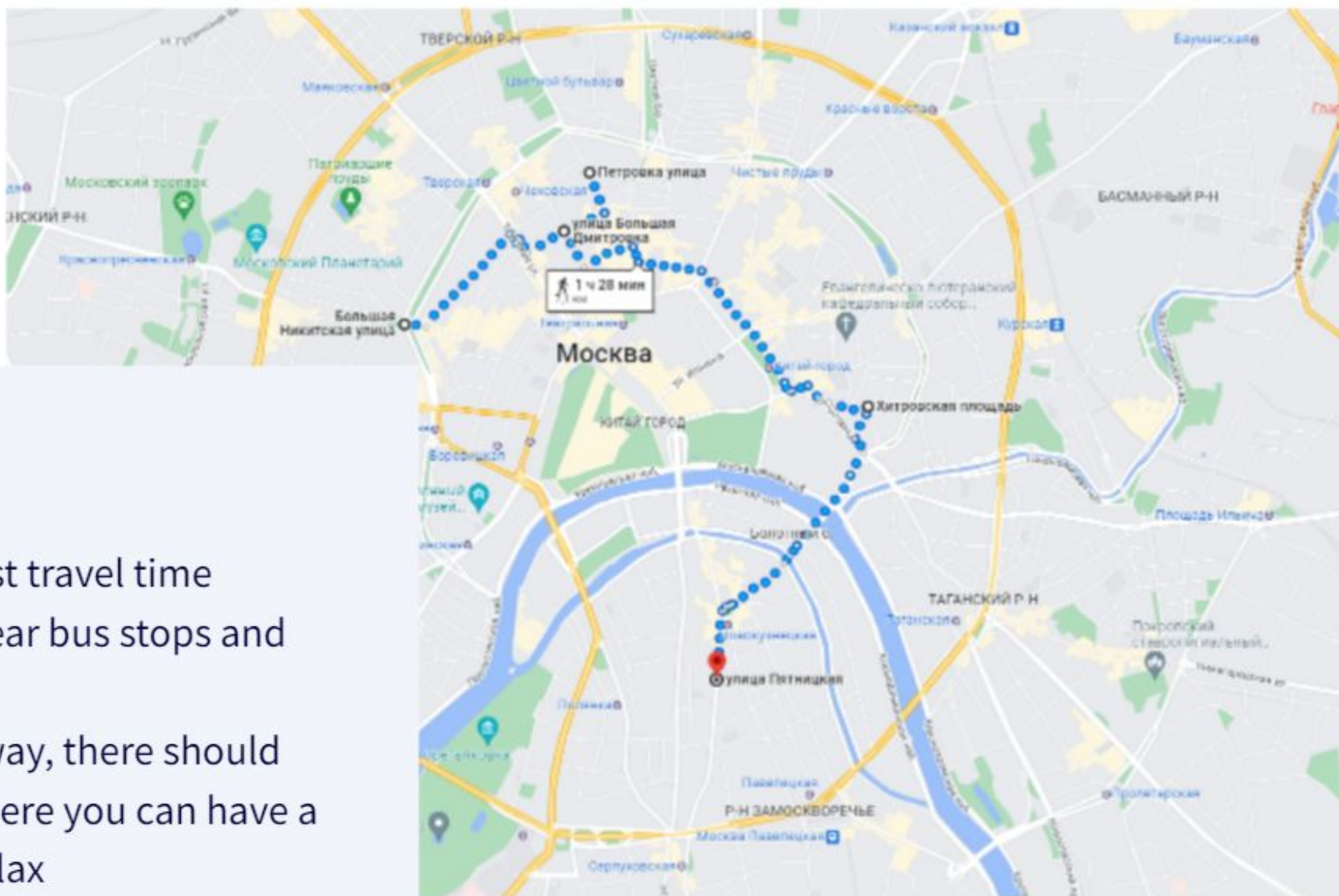

Pyatnitskaya Street

Pyatnitskaya was originally built as a road to Serpukhov, Tula and Ryazan. It started as a large trade route, and then turned into a shopping street. She is still like that.

Bolshaya Dmitrovka

Bolshaya Dmitrovka got its name because a long time ago there was a route to the city of Dmitrov.



Step by step, settlements of workers were formed along the road. But later rich people kicked them out.

Petrovka



This is one of the oldest streets in the center of Moscow. It is well known that the Main Directorate of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Russian Federation for the city of Moscow is located on Petrovka.

Petrovsky Lane connects Bolshaya Dmitrovka and Petrovka Streets, having a length of about 300 meters.

Khitrovskaya Square

Not only respectable citizens, but also representatives of the authorities and law enforcement tried to avoid one of the most criminal districts of Moscow. Khitrovka's fame was extremely bad.

"Sometimes there were terrible nights on this square, where drunken songs, the screeching of beaten "marukh" and the cries of "guard" merged. But no one dared to go to the rescue: they would let him go naked and naked, and even beat him for not climbing where he shouldn't."

Originally - just Nikitskaya, today...

Bolshaya Nikitskaya Street

It got its name from the Nikitsky Convent located on it. Soon everything here became Nikitsky - first the gates of the White City, demolished at the end of the XVIII century, then the square formed in their place, then the street adjacent to the square became Malaya Nikitskaya.

Первоначально - просто Никитская, сегодня...

Большая Никитская улица

Получила свое название от Никитского женского монастыря, расположенного на ней. Вскоре все здесь стало Никитским - сначала ворота Белого города, снесенные в конце XVIII века, затем площадь, образованная на их месте, потом и улица, примыкающая к площади, стала Малой Никитской.
