# SIMPLE SENTENCES

- **SUBJECT**

# SIMPLE SENTENCES

## COMPOUND SUBJECT:

Two or more people, places, or things with the same predicate

Examples:

**John and Sussy** like ice cream.

**Madrid and Paris** are two beautiful cities.

**These tables and chairs** are painted white.

# SIMPLE SENTENCES

## COMPOUND PREDICATE:

One subject doing two or more things

Examples:

Pablo **danced and sang** all night.

The pretty blue bird **drank and ate** fast.

# Simple sentence definition

---

- A sentence containing only one independent clause and no dependent clauses : “He went home after class.” ( *Compare complex sentence, compound sentence, and compound-complex sentence.*)
