
























FACTS:

- 3. The first elevator and railway school in Russia appeared here.










- 4. Elets lace is a very well-known product in its field, which has received recognition even at exhibitions in Paris.

- 6. Such famous people as the writer I. A. Bunin, the composer T. N. Khrennikov, N. N. Zhukov lived in Elets.








7. There used to be a Catholic church 4in Elets.

9. The pride and sorrow of Yelets: a bridge of tombstones.
























Vorgol Rocks


Memorial sign in honor of the 850th anniversary of the founding of the city of Yelets






