WHAT DOES FEMINISM MEAN?

- the belief in the social, political, and economic equality of the sexes

WHAT FEMINISM IS NOT

- Hating men
- Being a lesbian
- A result of “daddy issues”
- The idea that women and men are the same

WAVES OF FEMINISM

- First Wave (late 19th – early 20th centuries)

Political and economic empowerment

- Second Wave (1950s-1990s)

Social equality; sexuality and reproductive rights were dominant issues

- Third Wave (since 1990ish)

Intersectional Feminism; “Micro-Politics”

- Fourth Wave (?)

THREE LEVELS OF SEXISM

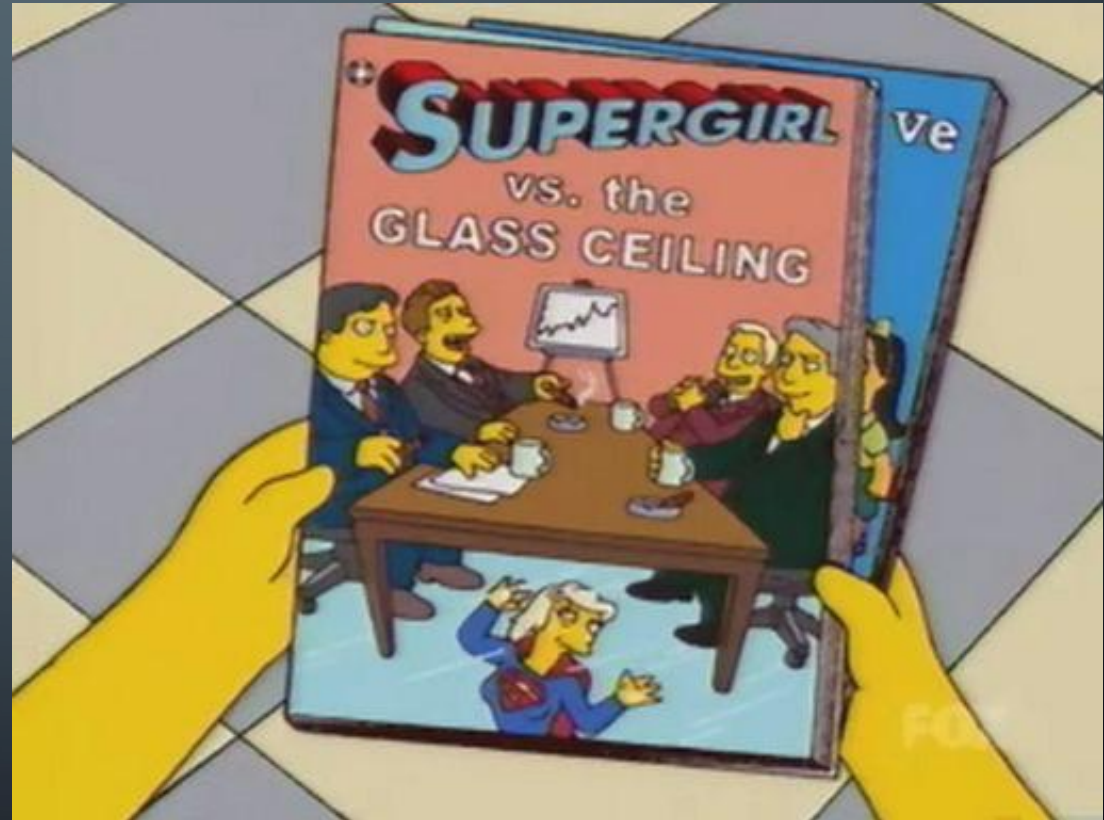
- Institutionalized Sexism

- Internalized Sexism

GLASS CEILING

10% of senior executives

4% of CEOs

75% of how much men earn



RAPE CULTURE AND VICTIM BLAMING

- 1 in 3 girls is sexually assaulted by the age of 18
- 80% of rape survivors know their assailant
- only 3% of all rapists face punishment
