



Some Facts about History of the College





The first students of the vocational school

When the vocational school was founded, the working professions for telephone communications were in great demand. The first graduates of the vocational school of communication were communication installers (монтажники связи), telephone equipment installers (монтажники телефонного оборудования), post office specialists (операторы почтовой связи) and others.

In 1980s the club of radio amateurs was founded. It's located in the hostel of the college. The leader of it for many years is Joseph Grigoryevich Dorfmann.




The participants of the club take part in many competitions every year and get medals and prizes.
