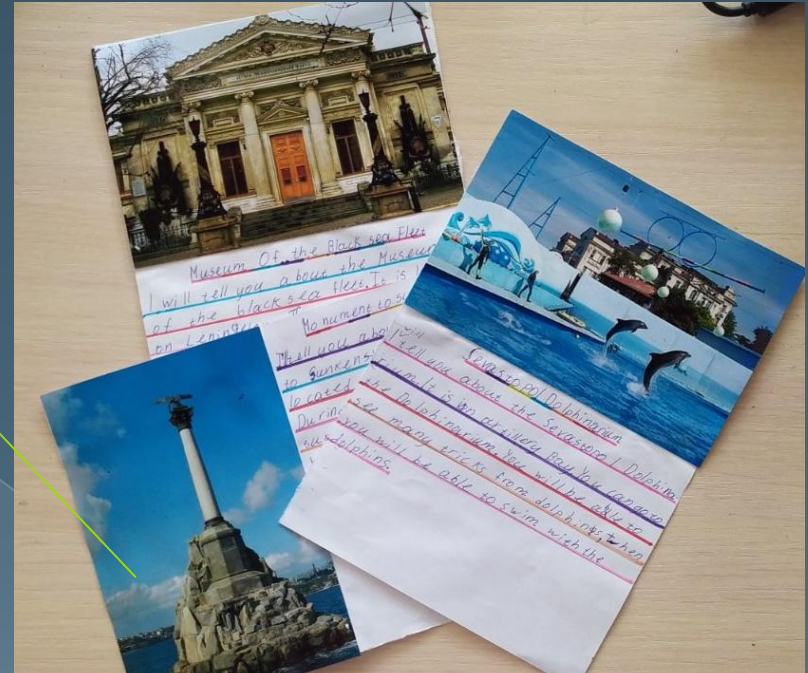

# Monument to the Sunken Ships

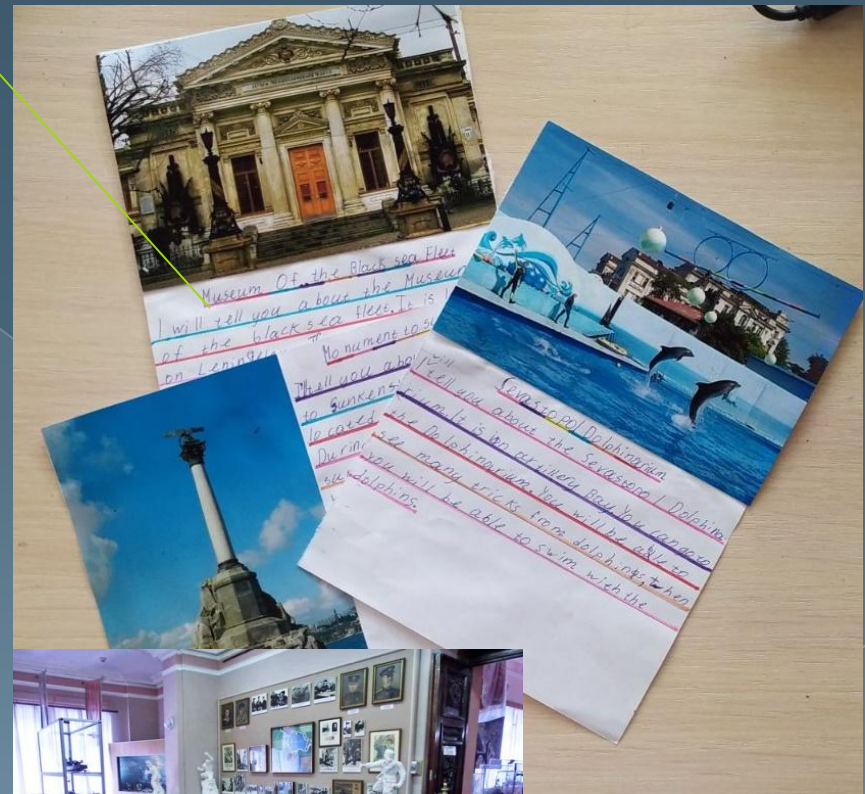
- One of the most recognized monuments in Sevastopol. You can see it on its coat-of-arms.
- During the war of 1854 the Russian ships were sunk by the Russian sailors to stop the enemy
- In 1905 the monument was built and quickly became the emblem of the city.





# Black Sea Fleet Museum
